Earlier, the makers of Raid 2 dropped its first look poster which features the legs and boots of the main character IRS Amay Patnaik played by Ajay Devgn. The poster has the tagline which reads, "Amay Patnaik is back", promising the return of Devgn as an honest government official who is at loggerheads with the powerful politicians.

Ajay Devgn and Vaani Kapoor to wrap Raid 2 shooting by April end: Report

Raid 2 is backed by Bhushan Kumar, Kumar Mangat Pathak, Abhishek Pathak, and Krishan Kumar under their banner T-Series and Panorama Studios respectively. It is slated to release theatrically on November 15th, 2024.

Raid is a 2018 crime drama film written by Ritesh Shah and directed by Raj Kumar Gupta. It starred Ajay Devgn, Saurabh Shukla, Ileana D'Cruz, Amit Sial, Vikram Kocchar, and Gayathri Iyer. The film follows the story of IRS officer Amay Patnaik who conducts an income-tax raid on a rich and corrupt politician.

It was based on the real-life account of Congress politician Sardar Inder Singh whose premise was raided by IT officers in the 1980s in Madhya Pradesh. It was particularly different from other raids as it was the longest raid in the history of India, lasting three days and two nights. Upon its release, the film became a critical and commercial success. Ever since then, there has been a lot of excitement surrounding the possibility of a sequel.

The movie stars Diljit Dosanjh and Parineeti Chopra in the lead and is a biopic of popular Punjabi singer Âmar Singh Chamkila who was gunned down in 1988 along with his wife.

The alleged reason for Chamkila's assassination shown in films and publicized in the past has been his double-meaning songs which weren't appreciated by a certain section of society. Imtiaz's movie also featured some of the singer's songs that were unfiltered and below the belt. Ali who made his debut in the genre of biopics with this one re-

vealed that he never thought he'd make a biopic. So what was special about Amar Singh Chamkila?

Imtiaz told Mid-day, "In Chamkila's story, there were so many things I felt I should address since they've been hidden from the audience. However, when depicting someone's life, you should have the liberty – not to change the facts, but to

Imtiaz Ali further said that he is not in favor of those biopics who endlessly glorify the person they are based on because it is 'very boring'. In Chamkila's case, the singer enjoyed a fair represent all aspects of them. If share of both love and hate and

Imtiaz felt that he had to present the human side of Chamkila. *He continued, "I did not set out*

to make him come across as this neat and clean person, which he was not. This is also because I knew a few intrinsic good qualities of him... He has flaws.

> Imtiaz expressed that if he had glorified Chamkila then he

would have become unrelatable. He added, "Sometimes it is the flaws and irregularities in a character that endear them to the audience. Then they know that this guy is human, thus enabling them to relate to and root for them."

Did you know Manisha Koirala rejected Dil Toh Pagal Hai out of 'silly insecurity' with Madhuri Dixit?

Manisha Koirala who last gave a hit almost a decade ago with Bhoot Returns is hoping for a solid comeback with Sanjay Leela Bhansali's Heeramandi. The actress will be playing the character of Mallikajaan in this period drama which is set to stream from May 1 on Netflix. Manisha while promoting the same looked back at her career and shared that one decision she regrets.

Talking about having silly insecurities, Manisha Koirala admitted that she rejected Yash Chopra's Dil Toh Pagal Hai because she was pitted against Madhuri Dixit.

Unknown to many, the character of Nisha who was eventually played by Karisma Kapoor was initially offered to several other actresses including Urmila Matondkar, Kajol, Raveena Tandon, Juhi Chawla, and Manisha Koirala. Unfortunately, Manisha is one of those who regretted the decision to back out.

Speaking with India Today, Manisha Koirala revealed, "One of the regrets that I have in my career is that I didn't do Yash Chopra's film. I was pitted against Madhuri ji [Dixit], and I



got scared. I backed out of that project.

Manisha confronted that every actor of her time wanted to work with the ace filmmaker at least once because of how he beautifully portrayed women onscreen. She added, "I went to Yash Ji's office and told him, 'Sir, it is my dream to be your heroine, solo. You are pitting me against Madhuri ji'. Somehow [because of] better judgment of mine, I think I missed out."

When filmmaker Raj Santoshi offered Madhuri Dixit-led Lajja to Manisha in 2000, the actress *immediately signed it because* she didn't want to repeat the same mistake. She shared, "I think when you have a strong maker, and when you are confident in your own skin, the security comes. I realized I didn't want to make that mistake again because of my silly insecurities. I am so glad I did it. I am so proud of Lajja."

In Heeramandi, Manisha will star alongside actresses Aditi Rao Hydari, Sanjeeda Shaikh, Richa Chadha, Sonakshi Sinha, and Sharmin Segal.
