Apr 24: Congress MP Rahul Gandhi on Wednesday claimed that ten years of Narendra Modi government saw only 22-25 persons becoming billionaires on the back of a Rs 16 lakh crore loan waiver, but if the INDIA alliance comes to power, it will make crores of people "lakhpatis"

Addressing a rally in Maharashtra's Amravati district, Gandhi also said no force in the world can change the Constitution of

He said a caste census "economic survey" will be conducted on priority if the INDIA alliance is voted to power and it will also waive

Targeting Prime Minister Narendra Modi, he said Modi only helped his 22 industrialist friends and waived their loans running into Rs 16 lakh crore.

"The 10 years of PM Modi's rule saw 22-25 persons becoming 'arabpatis' (billionaires). If voted to power, the INDIA alliance will create crores of 'lakhpatis'," Gandhi said.

The Congress, which is a part of the opposition IN-DIA bloc, has listed the Mahalaxmi scheme and the right to apprenticeship the various promises made in its manifesto for the ongoing Lok

He said if voted to power, the Congress would double the income of Aasha and Aanganwadi workers and grant 50 per cent reservation to women in government and public sector jobs.

"Our government will waive farm loans and will set up a farmers commission which will waive loans when the need arises," the Congress leader said.

He alleged that the Modi government didn't invite President Droupadi Murmu for the consecration of the Ram temple in Ayodhya and the inauguration new Parliament building.

He said tribals are not "vanvasis" but "adivasis", who are the first owners of Hindustan".

"Our government will conduct a caste-based Census and the economic survey which will be a revolutionary step in the national interest," Gandhi said.

ECIL, BEL refuse to disclose names of manufacturers of EVM, VVPAT components under RTI Act

Electronics Corporation of India Ltd and Bharat Electronics Ltd have refused to disclose the names and contact details of the manufacturers and suppliers of various components of EVMs and VVPATs under the RTI Act citing "commercial confidence", according to RTI responses from the PSUs to an activist.

Activist Venkatesh Nayak had filed two identical Right To Information applications with the ECIL and BEL, seeking the details of the manufacturers and suppliers of various components used in the assembling of the electronic voting machines (EVMs) and voterverifiable paper audit trail VVPATs). The VVPAT is an independent vote verification system which enables electors to see whether their votes have been cast correctly.

The ECIL and the BEL, public sector undertakings under the Ministry of Defence, manufacture EVMs and VVPATs for the Election Commission.

Nayak also sought a copy of the purchase orders for the components from both



'Information sought is in commercial confidence. Hence details cannot be provided under Section 8(1)(d) of the RTI Act," BEL said in its response.

A similar response was sent by ECIL which said the details requested are related to a product which is being manufactured by ECIL, and third party in nature. "Disclosing of details will

affect the Competitive position of ECIL. Hence, Exemption is claimed under section 8(1) (d) of RTI ACT, 2005," it said.

In response to the purchase order copies, ECIL's central public information officer said the information "voluminous" which would disproportionately

Public Authority.

"Further, the information will give away the design details of EVM components. The same may pose a danger to the machines produced. Hence, the exemption is claimed U/s 7(9) and under section 8(1)(d) of RTI Act, 2005," ECIL said.

Section 8(1)(d) of the RTI Act exempts from disclosure the information, including commercial confidence, trade secrets or intellectual property, the disclosure of which would harm the competitive position of a third party, unless the competent authority is satisfied that larger public interest warrants the disclosure of such information.

Section 7(9) of the Act

ordinarily be provided in the form in which it is sought unless it would disproportionately divert the resources of the public authority or would be detrimental to the safety or preservation of the record in question.

"I don't know whose interests they are trying to protect against the right to know of close to a billionstrong electorate. ECIL said that disclosure of the purchase orders will reveal the design details of the components and this may pose a danger to the machines produced. ECIL did not upload even a signed copy of its reply on the RTI Online Portal," Nayak said.

He said it is reasonable to infer that the two companies are not manufacturing every single item of the EVM-VVPAT combo or else the two companies would have replied that they are manufacturing all these components internally without any outsourcing being involved.

Thr Indian Mujahideen had taken responsibility for the attack in which a girl was killed and 20 persons sustained injuries. Akhilesh Yadav was the chief minister at that time. 
Excise scam: Delhi court directs CBI to file documents detailing statements of accused, evidence

LUCKNOW, APR 24: Samajwadi Party president Akhilesh Yadav will contest the Lok Sabha elections from Kannauj, the party announceď on Wednesday, two days after it had declared another candidate for the Uttar Pradesh seat.

The party said Akhilesh Yadav will now file his papers on Thursday, when nominations begin.

"National president Akhilesh Yadav will file his nomination papers from the Kannauj Lok Sabha seat at 12 pm tomorrow as Samajwadi Party candidate," the party posted in Hindi on X in the evening.

On Monday, the SP had declared his nephew Tej



Pratap Yadav as its candidate from the Kannauj parliamentary seat.

Earlier in the day, when reporters asked Akhilesh about his plans, he said, "It will be clear before the nominations." "Maybe you will get to know before nominations," he said, answering further questions.

Dimple also won in 2014 but lost the seat to BJP's Subrat Pathak in 2019.

On Tuesday night, posters in support of Vadra, the husband of Congress leader Privanka Gandhi, were seen at many places, including the Amethi Congress office, with the slogan "Amethi Ki Janata Kare Pukar, Robert Vadra Abki Baar".

Roughly translated, it says the people of Amethi want Robert Vadra this time.



While the local unit of the Congress blamed its opponents for putting up the posters to create confusion, the district administration has started removing them.

It is yet to declare its candidate for the Amethi seat and there is still doubt over Rahul Gandhi's candidature from the parliamentary constituency. Vadra has recently

thrown hints that he is keen to contest the Lok Sabha election from Amethi. He told reporters in Mathura earlier this month that the people of Amethi want him to represent them.

"They want me to represent them, go to their area and listen to their problems so that they can progress. I am also interested in joining politics...," he had said then.
