

Mission YUVA: DC Kulgam distributes sanction letters among 47 beneficiaries

As part of the ongoing efforts to promote youth empowerment and entrepreneurship, 'Roz-e-YUVA' program under Mission YUVA initiative of the government was today held at the Conference Hall of Mini-secretariat Kulgam.

The event organised by the District Employment Of-

fice, Kulgam in collaboration with J&K Bank was presided over by the District Development Commissioner (DDC) Kulgam, Athar Aamir Khan and attended by the ADDC Kulgam, Altaf Ahmad Khan; ADC, Viqar Ahmed Giri; ACD, LDM Kulgam, Cluster Head JK Bank, Assistant Director Employment, other senior administration and Bank officers.
