- After opening of the tender if the rates quoted by the lowest bidder are found to be high & value of work is more than the advertised cost, he/she is advised to negotiate his/her quoted rates with the department / offer his/her consent within five days after opening of the tenders, failing which the work shall be put to fresh tender.
- Vide Finance Department Circular No. 01 (Adm) FD of 2025 Dated:- 08-07-2025. Every participating supplier/contractor to mandatory disclose the bank account number which is linked with their GSTIN at the time of bid submission no payments shall be released by the Government Department/Agency to any other bank account except the one linked with the GST registered number of the successful bidder.
- Bid must be accompanied with cost of Tender Document in shape of Treasury Challan Debited to MH 0515 REW and earnest money in the shape of CDR @ 2% of the advertised cost in favour of Executive Engineer REW Division Poonch failing which the tender will be rejected out rightly. - Successful bidder will submit 3% additional performance security in the shape of CDR/FDR/ B.G. The total 5% will be released after completion of defect liability period of the work.
- As per Order issued by this office vide No. XEN/REW/P/4058-61 Dated:-21-02-2025. The Extra CDRs shall be released after successful completion of works.
- The lowest bidder shall have to provide the CDR/FDR/B.G. within weeks' time for the issuance of allotment failing which he/she will be recommended for black listing. The CDR issue date to be uploaded, shall not before the date of e-NIT and no other CDR shall be accepted as replacement, under rules.
- The successful bidder / Contractor who fails to start work within seven (07 Days) from the date of issuance of Allotment will be imposed a penalty of Rs 200 / Day starting from 8th day, deductible from the running/final bills of contractor.
- The tender receiving authority reserves the right to accept or reject any tender or all tender without assigning any reason there off.
- No tender document will be accepted displaying firm/company name without proprietor name against which the tender documents will be submitted.

Jammu & Kashmir Khadi and Village Industries Board (KVIB) - District Office Rajouri today organized an awareness programme at Hanjana Khanka, Bareri Nowshera to promote self-employment schemes- the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) and Jammu & Kashmir Rural Employment Generation Programme (JKREGP)

Educated unemployed youth, aspiring entrepreneurs, artisans and members of the civil society were acquainted with self-employment opportunities available under PMEGP and JKREGP schemes.

District Officer KVIB Sameer Ahmed highlighted the objectives, eligibility cri-



teria, financial assistance pattern, margin money subsidy and application procedure for availing the benefits of the twin schemes. Participants were informed about the scope of establishing income-generating units in manufacturing, service and business sectors. The importance of entrepreneurship development for sustainable livelihood generation and rural economic development was emphasized. Detailed guidance was provided regarding online application procedures, documentation requirements and bank linkage for sanction of cases. The programme concluded with an interactive session wherein the queries of the participants were addressed satisfactorily.

SKUAST-K hosts Bengaluru biotech leaders to strengthen industry-academia ties

SRINAGAR, MARCH 5: Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology of Kashmir (SKUAST-K) hosted a high-level strategic meeting today to strengthen collaboration between academic research and industrial innovation.

Chaired by Vice Chancellor, Prof. Nazir Ahmad Gana, the session brought together prominent biotechnology and nutraceutical entrepreneurs from Bengaluru, Karnataka, to explore interdisciplinary partnership opportunities. The meeting focused on bridging the gap between laboratory-scale research and commercial technology transfer, specifically targeting sectors like sericulture, biotechnology, and functional food development.



The industry delegation including, Dr. Srinivas, CEO, Aspartika Biotech Pvt Ltd; Dr Mousumi Mondal, Director, Mallipatra Nutraceutical Pvt Ltd; Aswathy Das, Director, Mightkondria Innovations LLP, and representatives from Lrugu Wellness Innovation LLP.

Coordinated by Dr Aabid Khaliq Tantray of College of Temperate Sericulture, Mirgund, the discussions identified several critical pathways for developing

market-ready products. The entrepreneurs briefed on their existing collaborations with institutions like Sri Paripurna Sanathana Ayurvedic Medical College, highlighting their experience in the scientific validation of nutraceutical and Ayurvedic formulations.

Primary focus of the deliberations was the establishment of a Common Instrumentation Facility to support advanced research in sericulture and the utili-

sation of its by-products. The participants also discussed the design of antibiotic-free poultry feed solutions and the creation of innovative nutraceutical formulations that leverage the unique biodiversity of the region.

The meeting also emphasized the need for industry-oriented academic and skill-based programs, student exchange initiatives, and the strengthening of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) facilitation to protect and commercialize university-led innovations.

The Vice Chancellor commended the visiting delegation for their efforts in building reputable enterprises from the ground up. He emphasized that such industry-academia partnerships are essential for accelerating innovation and translating scientific research into socially impactful, commercially viable solutions.
