## Preity Zinta Sells Bandra Apartment For Whopping Rs 18.50 Crore

Bollywood actress Preity Zinta has sold her Bandra apartment for a whopping Rs 18.50 crore. As per property registration documents accessed by CRE Matrix, the apartment, which was sold for a hefty amount, was allotted to Zinta in April 2025 after the old building was re-developed. This real estate sale is the second in recent times; in November 2025, Preity Zinta sold another property for about Rs 14 crore.

As per the report, this new property sale was registered on March 2, 2026. In this deal, Zinta sold an apartment spread across a carpet area of 1,770 sq ft. As for the new owners, according to the documents, Priya Nagar and Rajeev Nagar, US citizens of Indian origin, have purchased the property. The deal was completed with a stamp duty payment of Rs 1.11 crore and registration fees of Rs 30,000.

"Under a redevelopment agreement between the society and the developer (Keystone Realtors/Rustomjee), the flat was officially allotted to her as Permanent Alternate Accommodation. This arrangement was formalised in an agreement executed on October 23, 2023," CRE Matrix said.

After taking an extended break from acting, Preity Zinta is making her return to the big screen with the period drama *Lahore 1947*. Directed by Rajkumar Santoshi and produced by Aamir Khan, the film is set during the time of the Partition of India.

In 2024, Preity announced the completion of the shoot and expressed her gratitude in a heartfelt post.
