

DC Ganderbal chairs District SPCA Meeting

Deputy Commissioner Ganderbal, Jatin Kishore, who is also the Chairman of the District Society for Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA), today chaired a meeting of the District SPCA at the VC Room, Mini Secretariat Ganderbal.

During the meeting, the Deputy Commissioner reviewed the functioning of the District SPCA and took stock of measures for prevention of cruelty to animals and promotion of animal welfare in the district.

The DC directed that any instance of cruelty to animals shall be dealt with strictly in accordance with the applicable provisions and stressed the need for prompt reporting and necessary action in all such cases. He called for close coordination among the Animal Husbandry Department, Municipal Council, Wildlife and other concerned agencies for timely intervention.

The Deputy Commissioner further directed that injured, sick or distressed animals be provided immediate veterinary treatment and that feasible shelter fa-



cilities in the vicinity be identified and made available wherever required for their safe care and rehabilitation.

He also directed the Animal Husbandry Department to mobilise rapid veterinary response teams for timely intervention in cases requiring urgent medical attention, rescue or treatment. The teams were directed to coordinate with the concerned agencies for prompt response to such cases.

The DC specifically reviewed the issue of stray dog management and directed the Municipal Council Ganderbal to undertake systematic identification and capturing of stray dogs for their rehabilitation, vaccination and sterilisation under the Animal Birth

Control programme.

He directed the Animal Husbandry Department to immediately operationalise the ABC Centre and ensure that vaccination and sterilisation operations are undertaken there in a timely manner. The Deputy Commissioner further directed all concerned stakeholders to ensure urgent compliance with the prescribed ABC guidelines and called for close coordination between the Municipal Council and Animal Husbandry Department for effective implementation of the programme.

The DC stressed upon the Municipal Council and Animal Husbandry Department to strengthen coordination regarding stray and abandoned animals and ensure appropriate arrange-

ments for their rescue, treatment, shelter and rehabilitation.

The Deputy Commissioner also emphasised the need for public awareness and sensitisation regarding responsible treatment of animals and directed the concerned departments to undertake awareness activities among local communities and other stakeholders.

The meeting was attended by Additional Deputy Commissioner, Ganderbal, Divisional Forest Officer, Sindh Division, Assistant Commissioner Panchayat, Ganderbal, Range Officer, Wildlife, Ganderbal, Chief Executive Officer Municipal Council Ganderbal, Chief Animal Husbandry Officer Ganderbal, besides other concerned officers.

DC Bandipora reviews measures to curb Illegal Mining

Deputy Commissioner Bandipora, Indu Kanwal Chib, today reviewed measures for coordinated supervision and surprise checking to curb illegal extraction and transportation of minor minerals in the district.

During the meeting, the District Mineral Officer (DMO) apprised the meeting about the measures being undertaken to monitor mining and transportation activities. It was informed that vulnerable mining locations have been geofenced, while vehicles involved in mineral transportation have been equipped with GPS tracking systems to facilitate real-time monitoring and prevent unauthorized extraction and transportation.

During the meeting, it was informed that notices have been issued in cases of violations and FIRs have



also been registered against those found involved in illegal mining activities.

The Deputy Commissioner directed that no mineral transportation vehicle should be permitted to operate without GPS tracking, and stressed upon strict monitoring of vehicles and movement of minor minerals. She directed the concerned departments to promptly share information, alerts and inputs regarding suspected illegal mining activities with the Police and district admin-

istration for coordinated action.

The DC further directed that Action Taken Reports (ATRs) be submitted on a monthly basis and called for continuous tracking of vehicles to identify and prevent unauthorized transportation of minor minerals.

The Deputy Commissioner also emphasized the need to strengthen infrastructure and field-level mechanisms to detect and prevent illegal extraction, directing the concerned de-

partments to identify gaps and take necessary measures to improve enforcement capabilities.

Among others, the meeting was attended by Additional Deputy Commissioner Bandipora, Deputy Superintendent of Police Bandipora, District Mineral Officer Bandipora, while SDM Gurez, SDM Sumbal, Executive Engineers, and Assistant Director Fisheries, besides other concerned officers attended the meeting virtually.

DDC Anantnag inspects SDH, SDM Office Dooru

ANANTNAG, SEPTEMBER 24: District Development Commissioner (DDC), Anantnag, Dr. Bilal Mohiuddin Bhat, today undertook a comprehensive visit to the Subdivision Dooru and inspected various public institutions, establishments and development projects.

The inspection focussed on reviewing their functioning, available facilities and



delivery of public services besides progress on ongoing works.

During the visit, the District Development Commissioner inspected the new SDM Office at Dooru, which is presently under construction, and reviewed the progress of the ongoing work. He directed the concerned officers to ensure timely completion of the project while adhering to the prescribed quality standards. He was briefed by officers from executing agencies about the physical and financial progress achieved on the project so far.

The DDC also visited Subdistrict (Model) Hospital Dooru and took stock of the healthcare facilities available to the public. He reviewed the availability of essential medical services and infrastructure and interacted with the concerned officers to inquire about the issues, if any, being faced during delivery of critical healthcare services. He further took first hand stock of different sections of this important institution and asked the staff to ensure smooth and quality service delivery to the patients visiting the hospital.

Interacting with the patients and attendants, the DDC enquired about the quality of the services and asked the staff to ensure all the available services are provided to them in the best possible way.

Concluding the visit, the DDC directed the concerned officers to ensure timely resolution of public issues and effective response to the citizens' concerns. He stressed the need for coordinated efforts among all departments to improve public facilities and ensure satisfying services to the general public.

The Deputy Commissioner was accompanied by CEO VDA, SDM Dooru, Tehsildar, BMO, AEE R&B and other concerned officers.

6. Bids must be accompanied by bid security and cost of documents and only relevant documents as mentioned in the above table in the form as specified in the bidding documents. The Cost of Tender given against each should be paid through Challan simply remitting into Treasury under MH: 0702 and uploading treasury Challan receipt along with Tender shall be pledged to Executive Engineer Irrigation Division Udhampur payable at Udhampur & earnest money in the shape of CDR/FDR shall be pledged to Executive Engineer Irrigation Division Udhampur & Shall be valid at least for 360 days from the date of opening of bids. Contractor should mention the name of the work on Top of the Treasury Challan otherwise the Challan shall not be accepted.

7. The bids for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 30 days from the date of opening of bids, if any bidder/tenderer withdraws his bids/tender during the said period or makes any modifications in terms and conditions of the bid, the earnest money of such bidder shall be forfeited.

8. The rates mentioned in the BOQ are at par with SSR 2022.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

A. Date of start will be reckoned from the date of opening of Financial bid, work has to be completed in all respects by or before the date mentioned in allotment letter.

B. In case the contractor failed to complete the work with in stipulated time frame, the department will not be responsible for payment of work done claim of the contractors.

C. The contractor to whom the SAsCI work has been allotted by this division shall upload a certificate issued by the concerned Assistant Executive Engineer, certifying that 70% of allotted SAsCI work has been completed, along with the requisite technical documents. Failure to upload the said certificate and technical documents shall render the tender liable to rejection.

D. "The bidder/contractor shall possess adequate knowledge, technical competence and practical experience in execution of Public Health Engineering (PHE)/Jal Shakti works and other associated PHE works. The bidder shall upload duly signed and stamped Certificate confirming that the contractor possesses sufficient technical knowledge, manpower, tools, equipment and experience for execution of PHE works. The certificate/undertaking shall be submitted and shall be treated as an essential document. Failure to upload the requisite certificate/undertaking shall render the bid liable for rejection.

E. The contractor shall execute the work with due care and caution so as to avoid any damage to the existing water-supply/PHE infrastructure, pipelines, valves, chambers, pumping machinery, electrical panels, cables, transformers, motors, pumps, fittings, fixtures and other electrical/mechanical equipment or utilities existing at or near the work site. In the event of any damage to the above-mentioned infrastructure/equipment caused directly or indirectly due to the contractor's operations, excavation, negligence, carelessness, improper handling, use of machinery/equipment, or acts/omissions of the contractor, his employees, labourers, agents or subcontractors, the contractor shall be wholly responsible for the same.

F. Royalty certificate from geology and Mining deptt at the time of making payment.

G. Expenses on inauguration etc. will be incurred by the contractor himself.

H. In case of abnormally low bids and to ensure quality of work extra Deposit at rates indicated will be deducted at the time of making payment.
