Cong holds protest, hundreds of leaders taken into custody at EC Office in Jammu

JAMMU, SEPT. 25 :AICC General Secretary I/C J&K Affairs Dr. Syed Naseer Hussain (MP) alongwith AICC General Secretary & CLP Leader G.A. Mir , Working President Raman Bhalla and other senior leaders were taken into custody by the police while leading a strong protest demonstration of hundreds of congress leaders and workers outside Election Commission Office in Jammu today.

The protestors burnt the effigy of Prime Minister Narinder Modi and CEC Gyanesh Kumar and raised strong slogans against Modi Govt. and Election Commission seeking action against CEC to save democracy.

Accompanied by senior leaders including CWC Member Vikar Rasool Wani, Working Presidents Tara Chand & Raman Balla, EX-MP Ch. Lal Singh, Former Minister Mula Ram, Yogesh Sawhney, Ravinder Sharma, Th. Balwan Singh, Th. Balbir Singh, G.M. Saroori, Jugal Kishore, Ved Mahajan, Shabir Ahmed Khan, Th. Manmohan Singh, Yash Pal Kundal, Rajnish Sharma, T.S. Tony, Hari Singh Chib and several other former Ministers, Ex-Legislators, DCC Presidents, Frontal Heads and Block Presidents, Dr. Naseer led a strong protest demonstration outside Election Commission Office at Bahu Plaza Jammu Today.

The police had a tough time to control the massive protest and had to take the senior lead-



ers including AICC General Secretaries into preventive custody along with hundreds of workers and taken to DPL Jammu. They were later released.

Carrying play cards seeking FIR and sacking of CEC Gyanesh Kumar Gupta, the protestors raised slogans against him and Prime Minister Narinder Modi and Home Minister Amit Shah and burnt the effigy of PM Narinder Modi and CEC Gyanesh Kumar.

A large contingent of Police force was deployed outside Election Commission Office to control the congress protestors from all over Jammu Province and Kashmir region too, espe-

cially from Jammu Urban and Jammu Rural and other districts including Mahila Congress workers , as part of nationwide protests by the Congress against the Election Commission against “Vote Chori”, following exposure by Indian Express vindicating the stand of LOP Rahul Gandhi.

AICC General Secretary Syed Naseer Hussain hit out strongly on the Modi Govt and the CEC for “Vote Chori” and manipulating the elections in the various Assembly ad Lok Sabha to help BJP. He said that LOP Shri Rahul Gandhi had charged the CEC of acting at the behest of Modi-Shah to help BJP win elections, by all sorts of illegalities, whereby over 13 crores voters have been deleted so far through SIR.

The Indian Express report has vindicated congress stand and the severe danger to democracy and election process by bypassing the two EC’s who have opposed CEC’s decision around 14 times in 10 months. He said that CEC Gyanesh Kumar is guilty of treason with the nation and should be arrested and sacked and prosecuted to save democracy in the country. The expose has established that all such unilateral actions of CEC on the behest of Modi Govt. were illegal and need to be reversed. He said that these manipulations had become evident from Haryana and Maharashtra elections and sufficient evidence was established from his Home State Karnataka also . He said that BJP and Modi Govt. has not only destroyed the electoral system but also indulged in breaking parties and bringing down the elected governments in all other illegalities to manage power despite anti incumbency .

He declared that till needful is done, the congress protests will continue all over country and demanded the resignation of PM Modi and HM Amit Shah for this heinous crime. He also announced the district wise protests in all districts of J&K on Sep. 28, to press for actions against CEC.

AICC General Secretary and CLP Leader G.A. Mir lashed out the Modi Govt for manipulating the series of elections in states and Lok Sabha against which LOP Rahul Gandhi and Congress Party had already presented evidence in public but the recent expose of Indian Express has brought out the entire truth behind the “Vote Chori” which is intolerable and threat to democracy. Mir said that entire election process has been hijacked by Modi Govt. to stay in power and Congress and other democratic forces will have to fight out on streets to protect democracy.

Several other senior leaders including Vikar Rasool Wani, Raman Bhalla, Ch.Lal Singh, Yogesh Sawhney also briefly addressed the gathering and targeted the CEC and Modi Govt seeking sack of Gyanesh Kumar and registration of FIR to save democracy.

Former PCC President Mr. Vikar Rasool Wani demanded the arrest of Mr. Gyanesh Kumar to restore the confidence of people in the election process . He said LOP Rahul Gandhi had already presented lot of the evidences of manipulations in the elections and

now same is vindicated .

Shri Raman Bhalla targeted CEC for destroying the democratic system in the country on the behest of the ruling party led by Modi-Shah. He said that LOP Rahul Gandhi has been carrying a struggle to save democracy for more than two years and now the entire design of BJP has been exposed by the Indian Express report against which people are up in arms.

Ch. Lal Singh (EX-MP) said that BJP and Modi Govt. is fully exposed for hijacking and manipulating the elections in the country and the congress party will not rest till CEC is removed.

Former Minister Yogesh Sawhney condemned the Modi Govt. and CEC for eroding the credibility of election commission and the electoral process in the country for which people will not spare BJP.

The protestors raised strong slogans “Vote Chor-Gaddi Chhor”, Gyanesh Kumar- Arrest Karo”, Modi-Shah resign Karo”.
