ed by people willing to go from South to North side Moreover, people who intend to go Akhnoor, Talab Tillo, Paloura etc shall adopt 4thTawi Bridge via

Bhagwati Nagar/ Canal head. Keeping in view the restrictions/diversions for hassle free passage of National Festival, the public in genera is requested to co-operate with the Traffic Police/Local Police and plan their travel accordingly to reach their
