

Siddhant Chaturvedi and Mrunal Thakur's Do Deewane Seher Mein teaser to release on January 19



An exciting romantic film update awaits the fans of cinema! The upcoming Valentine's Day is gearing up for a fun and love-filled run at the box office with the release of Siddhant Chaturvedi and Mrunal Thakur starrer Do Deewane Seher Mein. As revealed exclusively to Pinkvilla, the upcoming romantic drama film will drop its first teaser on January 19, 2026. The Monday revelation is said to bring a surprise for the viewers as well as unlock a new look at the story between the two lead characters.

As per a source close to the film, "Zee Studios and Bhansali Productions will unveil the teaser of their upcoming film Do Deewane

Seher Mein on January 19. The teaser will serve as a perfect Valentine's Day-season treat for audiences. It will also have a pleasant surprise for viewers."

Said to be a Ravi Udyawar directorial, in collaboration with Sanjae Leela Bhansali, Prerna Singh, Umesh Kumar Bansal, Bharat Kumar Ranga, and Kalpana Udyawar, it is eyeing a premiere during Valentine's week this year. Zee Studios, Raincorp Media, and Bhansali Productions are helming the project. Apart from Siddhant Chaturvedi and Mrunal Thakur, actress Ila Arun is believed to be tied to the film.

Previously, a teaser poster for the film was revealed online, with

the characters of Siddhant Chaturvedi and Mrunal Thakur being shown in a blissful state as he rests his head on top of hers. The story of the film goes about like this: "Do dil, ek seher, aur ek imperfectly perfect prem kahani! This Valentine's Day, isq se isq ho jayega!" (Two hearts, one city, and one imperfectly perfect love story! This Valentine's Day, you'll fall in love with love!).

Interestingly, Do Deewane Seher Mein has a unique way of going about its name, with the word 'seher' being written in the Devanagari script, unlike the rest of the title. Do Deewane Seher Mein is all set to be available on big screens from February 20, 2026.

Chiranjeevi starrer goes overdrive on Sankranti, Gross 137cr worldwide in 4 days



Mana Shankara Vara Prasad Garu had a fantastic Sankranti day at the box office, as the film collected Rs. 26 crore in India on Thursday. The film witnessed a 20 per cent jump in collections from the previous day, which takes its four-day running total at the Indian box office over Rs. 100 crore, at Rs. 110 crore approx. Additionally, it has grossed Rs. 27 crore (USD 3 million) approx internationally, giving it a worldwide box office gross of Rs. 137 crore.

The Chiranjeevi starrer saw growth all across the board, whether it was in Telugu states or Karnataka, & Rest of India. In Telugu states, the film grossed Rs. 21.50 crore approx, with an outstanding showing in Andhra

Pradesh in both Coastal Andhra and Ceded districts. It was feared that Nizam would not be doing as well, but the film has delivered superb grosses so far. In Andhra Pradesh, the film was essentially at capacity yesterday. In some centres, the film hasn't got the appropriate shows because of competition from other films. Here, the film was reported to be turning away hundreds of audiences because of a lack of capacity. This excess demand is not just overflowing to other films but should be leading to spillover in the days to come.

The total gross in Telugu states stands at Rs. 95 crore approx. It will be crossing Rs. 100 crore mark today on the fifth day of its release. Today will be another stellar day

at the box office, likely on par or better than yesterday. Then there are two weekend days which should see strong returns as well. By Sunday, the film will be around Rs. 175 crore in India, of which Rs. 150 crore plus will be from the Telugu states.

Over the years, director Anil Ravipudi has built an enviable track record during the Sankranti festive corridor, delivering multiple major grossers. This includes last year's blockbuster Sankranthiki Vasthunam, which grossed nearly Rs. 200 crore in the Telugu states. Mana Shankara Vara Prasad Garu appears likely to top that, and that will add another win in his formidable Sankranti resume.

Dhurandhar 2 Exclusive: Aditya Dhar begins work on trailer cut of Ranveer Singh starrer, No extra shoot for Akshaye Khanna

Reports are doing the rounds that Akshaye Khanna has joined the sets of Dhurandhar 2 to shoot additional scenes. However, Pinkvilla has exclusively learned that Akshaye is NOT shooting for any scenes. While the actor is very much a part of the highly anticipated sequel, there is no fresh shoot involving him currently underway.

According to our sources, Akshaye Khanna's presence in Dhurandhar 2 will be limited to a couple of flashback scenes, which were shot during the film's initial schedules. "There is no additional filming happening with Akshaye Khanna at the moment. His portions were wrapped earlier and are part of key flashback moments in the narrative," a source clarified, putting speculation to rest.

Meanwhile, work on Dhurandhar 2 has entered a crucial post-production phase. Director Aditya Dhar is presently locked in on cutting the film's trailer. Yes, the makers are aiming for trailer release by the end of February. "Aditya is sitting on the trailer edit. The idea is to deliver something impactful again," an insider revealed.



Adding to this, the source revealed, "Shashwat Sachdev has simultaneously begun work on the film's background score. Both sound and visuals are being treated as top priority." No stone is being left unturned as the team gears up for Dhurandhar 2 re-release in cinemas on March 19.

Given the phenomenal success of Dhurandhar, the first part of

Ranveer Singh starrer emerged as a box-office juggernaut, posting extraordinary numbers and cementing its place among the biggest hits of 2025. Its record-breaking run has raised audience expectations for the sequel.

Prabhas is currently involved in the making of his much-awaited movie Spirit, directed by Sandeep Reddy Vanga. As the cop action drama is already making headlines, the makers have officially announced that the film will be released in theaters worldwide on March 5, 2027.

Taking to their official social media handle, the makers wrote, "No looking back!!! Spirit will see the world in theatres on March 5, 2027."

Spirit is an upcoming cop action drama starring Prabhas, who will be seen playing a hot-headed IPS officer. Triptii Dimri plays the female lead. Apart from the duo, the film also stars Vivek Oberoi and Prakash Raj in pivotal roles.

The film is set to be released in multiple languages, including Telugu, Hindi, Malayalam, Tamil, Kannada, Japanese, Chinese (Mandarin), and Korean.

Recently, the makers unveiled the first look of the movie featuring Prabhas and Triptii. The look showcases the Rebel Star in a rugged, long-haired appearance, standing tall and firm despite several wounds on his body, while holding a bottle of whiskey



in his hand. As he puffs on a cigarette, Triptii's character, touted to be his wife, is seen lighting it for him.

Prabhas was last seen in a lead role in The Raja Saab, directed by Maruthi. The horror-comedy film follows the story of Raja, a young man searching for his grandfather, as his grandmother is constantly haunted by memories of

him. As clues lead Raja to Hyderabad, he discovers that his grandfather's malevolent spirit resides in a mansion, haunting everyone around. How Raja manages to survive his grandfather's hauntings is explored in the rest of the film.

Apart from the Saaho actor, the movie also stars Sanjay Dutt,

Nidhi Agerwal, Malavika Mohanan, Riddhi Kumar, Zarina Wahab, and several others in key roles.

Looking ahead, the actor has pending work to complete on the period action drama Fauzi. Directed by Hanu Raghavapudi, the film is expected to feature Prabhas as an Azad Hind soldier during the British Indian era.
