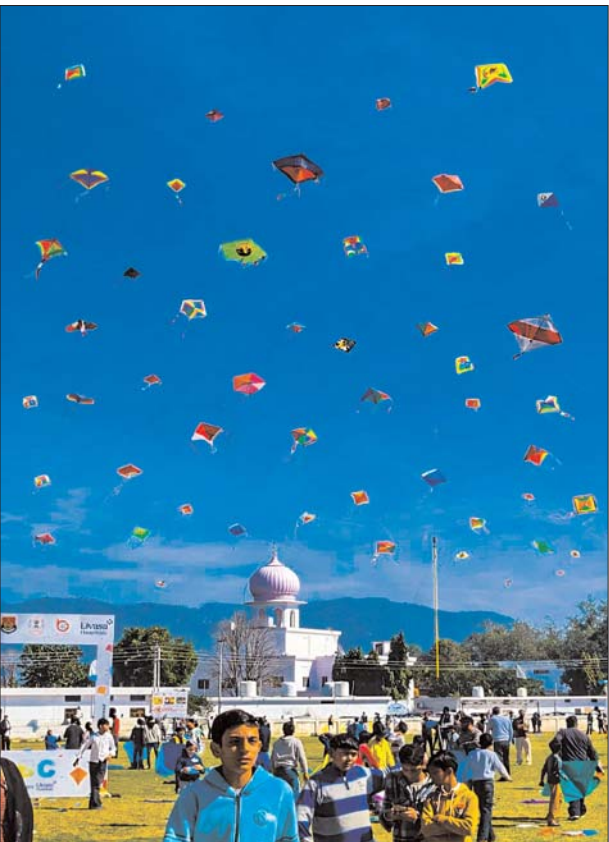
Livasa Hospitals Backs Nangal Kite Fest
