

Meeting with AIFF president

AIFF President Shri Kalyan Chaubey assured former Indian footballer Arun Malhotra that elections for the Jammu & Kashmir Football Association would be conducted soon, paving the way for structured governance and sustainable football development in the region.

Mr. Arun Malhotra, once again lays emphasis on conducting of JKFA elections for streamlining the football activities in Jammu and Kashmir. In a significant development Former Indian footballer Arun Malhotra met the President of the All India Football Federation (AIFF), Shri Kalyan Chaubey, at the AIFF Headquarters on 5th February 2026, raising critical issues related to the revival and development of football in Jammu & Kashmir.

During the meeting, Malhotra reiterated the urgent need for the formation of the Jammu & Kashmir Football Association and the conduct of elections at the earliest, stating that the winter season has ended and the football season in Jammu & Kashmir is about



to begin. He highlighted that there has been no local football league in the region for the past several years, which has severely impacted competitive football and player development. He briefed the AIFF President that sooner JKFA elections are held and body is formed, the football activities are revamped, and this sport of masses can be saved from further derailment in Jammu and Kashmir. sharing his vision and expertise spread upon decades of experience, he emphasised on the need to strengthen grassroots football, introduce structured youth development pro-

grammes, and organize regular coaching education initiatives to improve the quality of training and longterm development systems. Malhotra suggests that more football grounds and infrastructure in Jammu can boost the game of football and provide more training opportunities and competitive exposure to young players. He further said that Jammu & Kashmir continues to produce many talented footballers, several of whom are currently playing in professional clubs across India. He stated that with proper infrastructure development, organized competitions, and quality

coaching education, the region has the potential to produce many more professional footballers. He further emphasized for co-opting private sectors and ex reputed footballers to strengthen and shaping the football in Jammu and Kashmir. He said that Jammu has many talented and committed individuals who possess the capability to organize tournaments, leagues, coaching courses and development programmes for the betterment of football. Empowering these local stakeholders with proper institutional support and official structures, he said, would significantly accelerate football development in the region. The meeting ended with positive note and AIFF President Shri Kalyan Chaubey assured that the elections would be conducted soon held and all these productive suggestions will be implemented for paving the way for structured governance, organized league systems, grassroots programmes, and sustainable football development in Jammu & Kashmir.

Samyal promoted to Inspector General in CRPF

Shri Ashok Samyal, a distinguished officer of the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) and a proud son of the soil from Jammu, has been promoted to the rank of Inspector General (IG) as per orders issued by the Government of India. The rank was formally conferred during a ceremonial pipping by the Director General, CRPF, in New Delhi.

Shri Samyal is the son of Shri Mani Ram Samyal and hails from Village Gho Brahmana, Vijaypur, District Samba, Jammu & Kashmir. With 35 years of exemplary service, his journey from rural Jammu to the senior leadership of the nation's largest central armed police force stands as a testimony to dedication, discipline, and perseverance. He joined the CRPF on 04 February 1991 and has since served in some of the most challenging internal security environments of the country, including Punjab during the militancy period, Jammu & Kashmir, and Left Wing Extremism-affected areas, besides



holding key command, training, and staff appointments across India. A significant part of his career has been devoted to training and institution building. He served as Principal of the Central Training College (CTC), Neemuch, and the Recruit Training Centre (RTC), Neemuch, and had the rare distinction of being the last Principal of CTC Neemuch in the rank of Deputy Inspector General. Under his leadership, RTC Neemuch secured first position at the All-India level, earning him the Union Home Minister's Disc and Commendation Letter. He also played a pivotal role in raising the first CIAT School of CRPF at Udharpod, Silchar, thereby strengthening the

Force's counter-insurgency training capability. His distinguished service has been recognised with several prestigious honours, including the President's Police Medal for Distinguished Service (2025) and the Police Medal for Meritorious Service (2014). He has also received Bronze, Silver, and Gold Discs from the DG, CRPF, along with multiple Commendation Discs and Letters from the DG, CRPF and the Union Home Minister, reflecting sustained excellence and professional merit throughout his career. A trained mountaineer, Shri Samyal was a member of the 1st Indigenous CRPF Mountain Expedition and successfully summited Jo-

gin Peak in the Himalayas, exemplifying courage, endurance, and leadership beyond operational duties. From an early age, Shri Samyal displayed a keen interest in sports and extracurricular activities. During his school years, he actively participated in sports, NCC, and cultural activities, took part in All-India School Games, participated in Republic Day Parade-related activities, and earned the 'C' Certificate of NCC—traits that later shaped his disciplined, balanced, and people-centric leadership style. He completed his schooling from SRMLHS School, graduation from SPRM College of Commerce, Jammu, and also pursued studies in the Law Department of Jammu University. Presently posted in Delhi, Shri Samyal has consistently acknowledged that the love, affection, blessings, and unwavering support of the people of Jammu—especially those from his native village—have been a constant source of strength, inspiring him to remain at the forefront in every field of service to the Nation.*

Union Budget 2026-27 is visionary blueprint for Viksit Bharat 2047: Rajiv Jasrotia

BJP MLA from Jasrota, Rajiv Jasrotia, today organized a press conference to highlight the key features and long-term vision of the Union Budget 2026-27, terming it a visionary, inclusive and future-oriented budget that lays a strong foundation for making India a developed nation by 2047. Prominent among those present on the occasion included Distt President Updesh Andotra , Distt Spokesperson Adv Shashi Pal , Co - Convenor Adv Kasturi Lal, Distt Vice President Anil Singh , Mandal Pardhan Logate Surinder Singh , Mandal Pradhan Dinga Amb Deepak Sharma , Samar Singh , Ashok Jasrotia besides others. Addressing the media, Rajiv Jasrotia expressed his sincere gratitude to all media representatives for attending and covering the budget discussion. He informed that a dedicated district-level team has been constituted for detailed outreach and discussions on the budget, comprising



the District Vice-President, party spokespersons, senior party members, Advocate representatives and Divinder Pathania ji, who will also share their perspectives on various aspects of the budget. Jasrotia said that the main objective of the press conference was to present a clear and factual understanding of the Union Budget 2026-27 to the public. He noted that the district leadership would be taking the lead in addressing the media, while the party remains fully focused on disseminating the budget's vision and benefits. Referring to the last eleven years of governance under Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the BJP MLA stated that the country has witnessed consistent and structural

economic transformation. "This budget is not an isolated document; it is part of a long-term journey. The Hon'ble Prime Minister has given a clear vision of Viksit Bharat 2047, and the Union Budget 2024-25 serves as a blueprint for achieving that goal while strengthening Atmanirbhar Bharat," he said. Jasrotia emphasized that due to sustained economic reforms, massive infrastructure investments and people-friendly tax measures, India has emerged as one of the world's leading economies. "This transformation did not happen overnight. It is the result of disciplined governance, policy continuity and focused development over the past decade," he added. Terming the budget

as futuristic and inclusive, the MLA said it has something for every section of society—farmers, youth, women, entrepreneurs, MSMEs, industries and common citizens. He stressed that unlike populist budgets, this one prioritizes long-term national interest with a clear 21-year roadmap toward a developed India. Highlighting major initiatives, Jasrotia pointed to investments in high-speed rail corridors, railway expansion, roads, tunnels and power infrastructure, which will strengthen India's growth engine. He said special emphasis has been laid on manufacturing and innovation, with targeted support for sectors such as biopharma, electronics, chemical parks and textile parks. MSMEs and startups will benefit from growth funds, enhanced credit guarantees and improved access to finance. In the agriculture sector, he noted that new schemes will be rolled out in selected districts, along with improvements in storage and post-harvest infrastructure.
