

Rhea Chakraborty Says She 'Still Believes In Love' Years After Sushant Singh Rajput's Death



For years, her name was in headlines for reasons she never chose. After the death of Sushant Singh Rajput in June 2020, Rhea Chakraborty faced intense public scrutiny and legal battles that kept her away from the screen. Now, nearly seven years later, the actress, in a chat with Hindustan Times, spoke about something she refused to let go of — love. Rhea is returning to acting with filmmaker Hansal Mehta's upcoming series. But before stepping back on set, she says she had to make peace with the idea that her acting career might be

over.
"Letting go of this dream of acting, which I had worked towards for over a decade, took many sessions of therapy. I had to stop thinking about it because I couldn't have it; I didn't get acting opportunities," she said.
She admits she initially turned down the project. "Hansal sir and the writer asked me what was stopping me. I told them I had left acting and they said that's all the more reason I should do it because it does not matter whether I do well or not. Now I'm glad I said yes, it was different coming on set, such a long life has been lived in the last seven years. It's like cycling, something you never forget."

Beyond work, Rhea became emotional while speaking about the women who stood by her when many stepped away. "My girl friends have shown me what true friendship is. To be loved for no reason and at the cost of their lives and livelihoods being in trouble is phenomenal," she says, calling singer-actor Shibani Dandekar "like a sister."
Rhea revealed that Shibani lost brand endorsements for publicly supporting her, something she only learnt later. "I'm grateful to have such women in my life, who lift each other up. On one hand I saw the worst side of humans but on the other side I also experienced the most beautiful side of humanity."

Mastiii 4 Actor Ruhi Singh Alerts Fans About WhatsApp Impersonator, Files Complaint

Actress Ruhi Singh, who was recently seen in Mastiii 4, has issued a public warning after discovering that someone is impersonating her on WhatsApp. Taking to Instagram on Sunday, February 8, Ruhi alerted her followers about a fake account operating under her name and photograph, and urged everyone to block and report the number 6369584327. She also confirmed that she would be filing a police complaint in the matter.
Sharing details of the impersonation, Ruhi posted screenshots of the fraudulent WhatsApp conversation, where the impersonator was seen discussing a supposed photoshoot. The messages claimed, "Mein ek photoshoot ka plan kar rahi hu, crazy one like just to cover my masti side and crazy side of mine. Want to capture the real side of mine. My masti and aap log ka creative ideas will make it best."
The chat went on to describe multiple "sides" of the actress, with the impersonator adding, "Actually I give my 100% to all my shoots and all, but I have my one more side that is baby side and my masti side. Wohi mera real side hai. U know na."
Clarifying the situation, Ruhi wrote in her caption that someone has been misusing her identity and messaging people while pretending to be her. On her Instagram Stories, she strongly advised fans to stay alert and avoid engaging with the fake account. "So this is not me. If you get any shady messages like this—pls block..." she wrote.
Visibly annoyed by the incident, the actress didn't mince words, adding, "Come on, do better. Impersonating someone? Get a life."
