

The sources told the publication that Raza is currently serving as a showrunner on a Netflix series and as per a recent mandate from the streaming platform, the showrunner should be present on set daily.

This very reason impacted the shooting schedule of Ragini MMS 3, forcing the makers to part ways with the director. The film's team is looking for a replacement but it seems like it won't go on floors any time soon.
