The Jammu & Kashmir Academy of Art, Culture and Languages (JKAACL) in collaboration with the Department of Performing Arts, Cluster University of Jammu is set to present its Dogri production “Jasma” at the 25th edition of Bharat Rang Mahotsav, organised by the National School of Drama.

The play will be staged at Abhinav Theatre on February 17, 2026, at 5 pm. The presentation at this prestigious international theatre festival marks a significant milestone for theatre in Jammu & Kashmir and highlights JKAACL’s sustained commitment to promoting regional languages and cultural expressions on national platforms.

“Jasma” is adapted from



the renowned Gujarati play “Jasma Odan” written by eminent theatre personality Shanta Gandhi and translated into Dogri by noted theatre figure Kavi Rattan Sharma.

The production reimagines the original folk legend within the Dogra cultural landscape, incorporating elements of the traditional

Haran folk form and indigenous cultural motifs.

Jointly directed by Dr. Abhishek Bharti and Aparna Kapoor with music composed by Vishal Pandita, the production brings together faculty members and students in a collaborative creative effort.

The play reflects the vibrancy of Dogri theatre and

its evolving contemporary identity.

Blacklisted vehicles suspended for three months in Doda to ensure road safety

In a major step to enhance road safety and ensure compliance with transport regulations, the Assistant Regional Transport Officer (ARTO) Doda, Kapil Deol has ordered the suspension of blacklisted vehicles for a period of three months with immediate effect. The action has been taken under the directions of Deputy Commissioner Doda, Harvinder Singh.

As per the order, vehicles found operating with expired Fitness Certificates and those running without valid Route Permits have been blacklisted and suspended from plying on public roads. Vehicle owners have been directed to renew their Fitness Certificates, obtain or renew Route Permits, or apply for



cancellation of Registration Certificates (RC) in case the vehicles have been scrapped.

The order further states that failure to comply within the stipulated three-month period will lead to

cancellation of the Registration Certificate, seizure of vehicles during enforcement drives and penal action under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

The District Administration reiterated that the step

has been taken strictly in the interest of public safety and road discipline, urging vehicle owners to adhere to legal norms and contribute towards safer roads in the district.

SMVDU Hosts 5-Day Residential Skill Development Program on Solar Photovoltaic Systems

The School of Electrical Engineering at Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University (SMVDU) successfully organized a five-day Residential Skill Development Program titled “Solar Photovoltaic Systems: Design, Installation and Maintenance”. The program was funded and supported by the Higher Education Department, UT of Jammu & Kashmir. The inaugural session was graced by Prof.

Pragati kumar, Vice Chancellor, SMVDU, as Chief Guest. In his address, he highlighted the vital role of renewable energy in sustainable development and encouraged participants to explore entrepreneurial opportunities in the solar sector. The first technical lecture was delivered by Prof. M. Rizwan, Delhi Technological University, who shared insights on solar PV design and emerging technologies. The training covered fundamentals of solar PV systems, component selection, inverter technolo-

gies, mounting structures, installation procedures, testing, and maintenance practices. Participants also engaged in extensive hands-on field training, including a visit to SMVDU’s solar rooftop plants, where they discussed system design, operational challenges, maintenance strategies, and return on investment calculations. Expert sessions were conducted by professionals from Gujarat Energy Research and Management Institute (GERMI) and PDF Engineers Pvt. Ltd.,

Ahmedabad, along with industry experts. The program saw enthusiastic participation from 46 attendees from the Jammu region. The program was coordinated by Dr. Kumud Ranjan Jha, Head, School of Electrical Engineering and Dean, Faculty of Engineering, with co-coordination by Dr. Prabhu Omer, Dr. Jatinkumar Soni, and Mr. Akash Deep. BRO Reopens Bhaderwah-Bani-Basohli NH

BHADERWAH, FEB 15: In a swift and coordinated operation amid extreme weather conditions, 69 RCC and 118 RCC of 35 Border Roads Task Force (BRTF) under Project Sampark of the Border Roads Organisation (BRO) successfully reopened the

strategic Bhaderwah-Bani-Basohli road at Chattergala Pass following heavy snowfall.

The recent spell of intense snowfall had disrupted vehicular movement along the 65-kilometre stretch, temporarily snapping the cru-

cial link between the mountainous regions. Demonstrating operational readiness and commitment to maintaining all-weather connectivity, BRO teams launched an intensive snow clearance drive in challenging terrain near the Ashpatti glacier and the foothills

of Mount Kailash.

Despite deep snow accumulation, sub-zero temperatures and difficult working conditions, the teams deployed men and machinery round-the-clock to restore traffic well ahead of the usual seasonal schedule.
