## Baramulla farmers meet BJP leader Billawaria

A deputation of farmers and representatives of various associations from Baramulla district, led by the Bhartiya Kissan Union (Lok Shakti), called upon the senior leadership of the Bharatiya Janata Party at the party headquarters in Trikuta Nagar, Jammu.

J&K BJP General Secretary Baldev Singh Billawaria accompanied by Media Incharge Dr. Pardeep Mahotra listened to their issues, while assuring them support to all genuine public welfare issues.

The deputation, representing the concerns of grassroots stakeholders from North Kashmir, was led on behalf of Devi Dutta, State President of Bhartiya Kissan Union (Lok Shakti). The delegation comprised District Chairman Rafiq Ahmed Khan, Youth Vice-President Syed Asiq Khan Hussain, Vice-President Kashmir Province Mohd. Azam Bhan, District President Akbar Din Manhas, Block President Khair Ali Mir, Mahila Youth President Maymoon Bano, and other prominent members.

During the meeting, the delegation highlighted several pressing issues affecting farmers and local resi-



dents of Baramulla and adjoining areas. They strongly demanded maximum local recruitment in the NHPC-2 project and the railway project from Baramulla to Uri, emphasizing that local youth must be given priority in employment opportunities arising from development initiatives in their own region.

The deputation also raised the issue of construction of bunkers for genuinely needy families residing within close proximity (up to 5 kilometers) of sensitive zones, stressing the urgent need to safeguard civilian lives.

They sought a review of aid grants under PMGSY housing allocations in their area, alleging misappropriation and irregular allotments, and urged that bene-

fits be extended strictly to deserving beneficiaries.

Among other demands, the delegation called for installation of Solar High Mast Lights at Braman village, operational strengthening of SDRF in Uri to effectively handle emergency situations, and expediting pending infrastructure works. They demanded PMGSY roads from Braman Rafiabab to Gibbarwal Gali, from Kambar to Dariyan, and from Rafiabab to the Upper Pahari Belt of Braman village to improve connectivity in remote areas.

The delegation further raised concerns regarding the lack of timely fire emergency services to mitigate fire-related damages and highlighted the stalled Jal Jeevan Mission project in the area, requesting imme-

diated intervention to resume the work for ensuring access to safe drinking water.

Baldev Singh Billawaria, assured the deputation that every genuine demand would be taken up with the concerned authorities at appropriate levels. He stated that the BJP government is committed to transparent governance, equitable development, and safeguarding the rights of farmers, youth, and marginalized sections of society.

Dr. Pardeep Mahotra said that the party stands firmly with the people of Baramulla.

He stated that the BJP has always believed in ground-level engagement and constructive dialogue to resolve public grievances effectively.

## MLA lays foundation stone for Modern Cricket Playfield in Jammu North

In a significant step towards strengthening sports infrastructure in Jammu North, MLA Jammu North Sham Lal Sharma today laid the foundation stone for the construction of a modern cricket playfield at Ward No. 59, Top Paloura (Thathariyan).

The project has received Administrative Approval of ₹200.00 lakhs under the Capex Budget and has been allotted at a cost of ₹130.14 lakhs. It will be executed by the Jammu and Kashmir Sports Council and is scheduled to be completed within nine months.

The playfield will be developed with proper levelling and grassing of the ground, construction of drainage facilities, boundary fencing, change rooms for players, practice and competition pitches, lighting arrangements, and other essential infrastructure to create a quality sporting facility for local youth. Necessary enabling works will also be undertaken to ensure smooth execution of the project.

Sham Lal Sharma also visited Government Primary School, Thathariyan, where two additional classrooms are



being constructed under the Samagra Shiksha Scheme at an estimated cost of ₹20.84 lakhs. The new classrooms, along with a verandah, will significantly enhance the learning environment for students. He reviewed the progress at the site and directed concerned officers to ensure timely completion with quality and transparency so that students may benefit at the earliest.

Addressing on the occasion, Sham Lal Sharma stated that sports infrastructure plays a crucial role in channelizing the energy of youth in a positive direction and in nurturing talent at the grassroots level. He emphasized that providing modern facilities in local areas will not only encourage participation in sports but also open pathways for young players to compete at higher levels. He further said that along with sports, continuous improvement in educational and civic

infrastructure remains central to his development agenda, aimed at building a progressive, empowered, and self-reliant Jammu North.

Sham Lal Sharma also expressed serious concern over the growing menace of drug abuse among youth and emphasized that strengthening sports infrastructure is a crucial step in combating this social challenge. He stated that constructive engagement through sports, education, and community participation can effectively divert young minds from harmful activities and guide them towards a disciplined and productive life. Bids must be accompanied with cost of Tender document in shape of e-challan through Treasury indicating Treasury Voucher No. & date, name / e-NIT No. of work duly crediting to 0059 (Revenue) favoring Executive Engineer PWD (R&B) Division, Chenani uploading a copy of treasury challan and EMD/Bid Security in the shape of CDR/FDR (The date of Treasury Challan/ Bid Security/Affidavits between date of start of bid submission and bid submission end date) duly pledged to Executive Engineer PWD (R&B) Division, Chenani as mentioned in the bid documents. The earnest money of the unsuccessful bidder shall be released only after submission of Treasury Challan.

2. The electronic bidding system would not allow any late submission of bids after due date and time as per server time. Bidders may modify their bids by uploading their request for modification before the deadline for submission of bids. For this, the bidder need not make any additional payment towards the cost of tender document. For bid modification and consequential re-submission, the bidder is not required to withdraw his bid submitted earlier. The last modified bid submitted by the bidder within the bid submission time shall be considered as the bid. For this purpose, modification/withdrawal by other means will not be accepted. In online system of bid submission, the modification and consequential submission of bids is allowed any number of times.

The bidders may withdraw his bid by uploading their request before the deadline for submission of bids; however, if the bid is withdrawn, the re-submission of the bid is not allowed. No bid shall be modified or withdrawn after the deadline of submission of bids.

3. The date and time of opening of Financial-Bids shall be notified on Web Site [www.jktenders.gov.in](http://www.jktenders.gov.in) and conveyed to the bidders automatically through an e-mail message on their e-mail address. The Financial-bids of Responsive bidders shall be opened online in the Office of Executive Engineer PWD (R&B) Division, Chenani. The date for same shall be intimated separately.

4. The bids for the work shall remain valid for a period of 120 days from the date of opening of Technical bids.

5. The bidder shall be disqualified from bidding for any contract with this office for a period of 03 Years from the date of notification, if:-

a) Any bidder/tenderer withdraws his bid/tender during the period of bid validity or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the bid.

b) Failure of Successful bidder to furnish the required performance security within specified time period after issue of letter of acceptance.

6.3 The bidders have to submit their bids online in electronic format with digital Signature. No financial bid will be accepted in physical form.

6.4 Bids will be opened online as per time schedule mentioned above.
