

Alia Bhatt, Ritesh Sidhwani To Attend 79th BAFTA Awards At London's Royal Festival Hall



Hollywood sensation Alia Bhatt is all set to present an award at the 79th edition of the BAFTA Awards. The prestigious ceremony, officially named the EE BAFTA Film Awards, celebrates excellence in filmmaking and artistic achievement across genres and languages. Hosted annually by the British Academy of Film and Television Arts, the award ceremony is scheduled to take place on February 22 at London's Royal Festival Hall. The event will see some of the most influential names from across the international film fraternity. But Alia Bhatt will not be the only Indian gracing the prestigious evening. Five Indian films have been nominated in the Best Film Not in the English Language category. These include Aamir Khan's Rang De Basanti (2006), the 1988 Salaam Bombay! as well as the 2001 film Monsoon Wedding (2001), the 2002 Sanjay Leela Bhansali film Devdas, starring Shah Rukh Khan in the lead role and the late Irrfan Khan-starrer The Lunchbox (2014).

Delhi HC Pulls Jubin Nautiyal For Not Filing Personality Rights Plea In Local Court

Singer Jubin Nautiyal had approached the Delhi High Court to safeguard his personality rights, and in recent times, several such cases have come to the notice of the Delhi HC. Now, following Jubin's plea, the Delhi HC has questioned the ace singer as to why he didn't approach a local high court rather than coming to Delhi, since he is based in Uttarakhand. The judge asked Jubin's lawyer why he didn't approach a court in Uttarakhand, where he is based, noting that courts exist there. Later, Jubin's lawyer argued that the singer chose the Delhi HC because authorities, including the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) and the Department of Technology (DoT), are located there. However, the court did not get convinced by the reasoning. As per Bar and Bench, the court asked, "What is the reason for coming here? Court in Uttarakhand can't call them (defendants) and pass directions? Are you saying Google is not available in Uttarakhand? You have to tell us this, no? Why Uttarakhand doesn't have jurisdiction when you yourself are located there? Is it the law that because the ministry is here, whatever will be against them, all jurisdiction, whether from Madras, Calcutta, or Bombay will come here?" In a statement given in December 2025, the singer said, "Music has always been very personal to me. My name, my face, and my voice are not just parts of my profession; they are deeply connected to who I am and to a journey that the audience has supported with immense love over the years. When these are used without consent, it affects more than just my work. It impacts the emotional bond I share with my listeners and my family, who have stood beside me through every step."
