Alicia Keys feels proud as her debut song, 'Fallin', is all set to turn 25 this March. Ahead of the special anniversary, the 17-time Grammy winner took a trip down memory lane and talked about her massively successful song.

During an interview with PEOPLE at She Is the Music's Women Sharing the Spotlight event, the pop icon talked about her feelings as the song reached a massive milestone.

Keys On 'Fallin' Turning 25

Discussing the upcoming anniversary, Keys shared, "I'm not sure how I wrap my head around this whole existence called life. It's very crazy and wonderful and ex-

citing and amazing."

She continued, "And just thinking back to that girl in me at that time and how she had no idea, none. That she was completely what you call 'fake it till you make it' — that's what she was doing, and she did a damn good job."

Talking about her journey, Keys shared, "The more I grew, the more I learned, and so I think about her, and I'm so appreciative of her because she was strong, she was clear. Even though she didn't know everything, she knew what she didn't want, and she knew what she had to hold onto, and that was authenticity and truth and honesty and music."

The Empire State of Mind singer further noted that she is "very proud" of her younger self because she "recognises her in me today. So that's a beautiful thing. So to be able to

come all this way and have all these years to be creating and to have not even hit the tiny bit of where I'm going is a really, really exciting thing. So I'm grateful," she added.

What Do We Know About 'Fallin'?

Released in March 2001, when Keys was 20, this song went on to become one of the biggest hits of that era. 'Fallin' spent six weeks at No. 1 on Billboard's Hot 100 following its release. Keys also won five Grammys in 2002 off the success of the hit love song and her Songs in a Minor album, including Song of the Year, Best Female R&B Vocal Performance, Best R&B Song, Best R&B Album and Best New Artist.

BAFTA 2026: Paul Mescal And Gracie Abrams Make Red Carpet Debut As A Couple



Paul Mescal and Gracie Abrams made it official at this year's BAFTA Awards. On February 22, the couple appeared on the red carpet hand-in-hand, marking their red carpet debut as a couple.

The pair, who have been going out for a while now, rolled in style at the ceremony, looking absolutely adorable.

The couple surprised fans as they walked together on the red carpet. Mescal was seen lovingly holding the *Thats So True* singer as she planted a sweet kiss on his cheek. Abrams looked gorgeous in a black floral gown as she came to support her man for his film *Hamnet*.

On the other hand, Mescal, who is nominated for his role as William Shakespeare in *Hamnet*, kept it classy with a black jacket and matching pants. He

paired the stylish ensemble with a white dress shirt underneath that was left unbuttoned at the top.

The couple have been romantically linked since they were first spotted in June 2024. According to TMZ, Mescal and Abrams were out on a date when the actor reached out to cup her face. Since then they have been spotted several times enjoying concerts and going on date nights.

Their official BAFTA red carpet appearance came shortly after they were spotted at this year's Golden Globes Awards. According to PEOPLE, we were photographed heading to Chateau Marmont after the award show. They were seen holding hands as they stepped out of the vehicle.

Previously, during an interview with Rolling Stone, Paul Mescal opened up about his relationship. The actor, who is generally private when it comes to his personal life, shared that he did not "know how to answer" a question regarding his relationship with the *Risk* singer.

"I actually do have an answer, but everything to do with that is deeply precious to me, and I don't want to. ... This isn't ... I don't really ... umm ... I want to protect those things fundamentally," he said at the time.

Paul Mescal was nominated for Best Supporting Actor for his role as William Shakespeare in the period drama *Hamnet*. This nomination marks his third BAFTA nod, following previous acknowledgements for *All of Us Strangers* and *Afternoon*. However, he lost the nomination to Sean Penn in *One Battle After Another*. *Hamnet* received 11 nominations, becoming the most-nominated film directed by a woman at this year's BAFTAs.

While neither Tara nor Veer has publicly confirmed the reports, the actress recently opened up about her emotional evolution in an interview with Elle India.

"I've learned how to protect my peace," she said, noting that this awareness did not come naturally to her when she was younger.

She reflected that if anything feels different about her today,



it is her comfort with stillness. When creative overwhelm strikes, her instinct is not to escape outward but inward — through reflection, solitude, or sometimes simply doing nothing at all. She shared that this, she believes, is the only way to calm the nervous system.

'I Would Rather Lose A Film Than Lose Myself'

Tara also described the defining thread of her career as her willingness to walk away when necessary. She admitted that she has often chosen her values over professional gain, even when it came at a cost.

"But I would rather lose a film than lose myself," she said.

Emphasising the importance of inner clarity over public noise, Tara added, "As long as I know the truth, and the people closest to me do, that's enough."

Speculation about her relationship gained further traction after she skipped Veer's recent birthday celebration in Mumbai and did not post a public message for him. Earlier, he was also seen attending Nupur Sanon and Stebin Ben's wedding reception alone.
