

Meerra Chopra Shares Disturbing Cab Experience, Says Driver Was 'Almost Sleeping'



Early morning rides are supposed to be smooth and stress-free. But for actor Meerra Chopra, a recent cab booking turned into what she described as a frightening ordeal. The actor took to social media to narrate her experience with Uber India, alleging serious safety concerns during the trip.

Posting on X (formerly Twitter) on Tuesday, February 24, Meerra detailed the incident and tagged the ride-hailing platform. She wrote, "Had a massively scary unfortunate experience with @Uber @Uber_India. Booked a cab fr 6 hrs early morning. Driver came dirty with a stinking and dusty car. When i asked him why the car is stinking i realised hes not able to talk also

coz he was almost sleeping while driving."

According to her post, she ended the ride within 20 minutes due to safety concerns and arranged another cab. However, she claimed that despite exiting early, she was charged for the entire six-hour booking.

Expressing her disappointment, she further wrote, "Safety standards in our country with public transport is deeply compromised and in situations like this companies like @Uber are trying to make money. Disgusting!!"

The actor's post has since drawn attention online, with several users reacting to her concerns about passenger safety and service standards.

Meerra, who is actor Priyanka Chopra's cousin, began her career in the South film industry before moving to

Hindi cinema. She made her Tamil debut with Anbe Aaruyire, starring opposite S. J. Surya. She later appeared in the Telugu film Bangaram, alongside Pawan Kalyan, followed by her performance in Vaana, directed by M. S. Raju.

In Hindi cinema, she made her Bollywood debut with 1920 London, directed by Vikram Bhatt, and co-starring Sharman Joshi. She also featured in Gang of Ghosts, directed by Satish Kaushik.

In 2019, she played Anjali Dangle in Section 375, sharing screen space with Akshaye Khanna and Richa Chadha. More recently, she turned producer with her first feature film Gandhi Talks.
