US, Israel launch joint attack on Iran

Trump says US carrying out 'major combat operations'

DUBAI, FEB 28: The US and Israel launched a joint daylight attack on Iran, targeting its leadership and military capabilities, in an operation dubbed 'Operation Lion's Roar'. The strikes, confirmed by US President Donald Trump and Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, aimed to eliminate Iran's nuclear and missile threats. Explosions were reported in Tehran, Isfahan, and other cities, with Iran's Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali

Khamenei reportedly moving to a secure location. Trump said the US had begun "major combat operations in Iran" after Israel launched strikes. Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) said it fired missiles at US military bases in the Gulf in retaliation for a major US-Israeli attack on Iran, with explosions reported in Bahrain, Kuwait, the UAE and Qatar. and Revolutionary Guards commander Mohammed Pakpour were believed to have been killed in Israeli attacks. In response, Iran launched retaliatory missile and drone attacks on Israel and US bases in the region, including the US Al Udeid air base in Qatar and the US Fifth Fleet headquarters in Bahrain. The attacks led to the closure of airspaces in Israel, Iraq, and several Gulf countries, and the suspension of flights by airlines like Air India and Lufthansa. The international community reacted with concern, with Russia con-

demning the attacks as "dangerous" and the EU calling for "maximum restraint". The US and Israel claimed the strikes were necessary to prevent Iran's nuclear ambitions, while Iran vowed to defend itself. Trump called on the Iranian public to "seize control of your destiny" and rise up against the Islamic leadership that has ruled the nation since 1979. Some of the first strikes appeared to hit areas around the offices of Ayatollah Khamenei, and Iranian media reported strikes nationwide, and smoke could be seen rising from
