

'Not Proving Anyone Wrong': Shanaya Kapoor On Unconventional Pairing With Adarsh Gourav, Vikrant Massey



Shanaya Kapoor recently starred in *Tu Yaa Main* alongside Adarsh Gourav, and before that, the actress paired with Vikrant Massey. While there was an evident height difference between her and Adarsh, the age difference became a topic of discussion in her debut film. Now, Shanaya Kapoor has opened up about how both castings were away from conventional norms.

Speaking to HT, she said, "It's not about proving anyone wrong. I can speak about myself, and I think as an actor, it is all about taking that risk, that's what excites me. If you read something and feel like, 'this is something that I've done, and let's go back into it,' I don't

know how exciting that would be for me. I want to look at a scene and be thinking, 'Oh my God, am I going to be able to pull this off or not? How do I pull this off? How do I find truth in this?' Those are the things that excite me personally, and that's where you hope to create that magic and see that little spark when you try to do something new and not stick to doing the same thing," Shanaya shared.

Shanaya also opened up about how the happy times are back and people have started coming back to the theatres. Speaking about the good times, she shared, "It's an exciting time for all actors and creators right now. The audiences are back in the theatres, and it's a very exciting feeling. The audience had stopped coming for a bit, but now, even for international films, people are going in groups for a film like *Marty Supreme* as well, which is also exciting. That's the fun that I missed for a while as an audience. So, of course, as an actor, it's just more exciting and motivating."

Shanaya was recently seen alongside Adarsh Gourav in *Tu Yaa Main*, which has generated buzz for its unique storyline and performances. Fans praised the chemistry between the leads and the gripping narrative.

The film follows the story of two content creators whose adventurous journey turns into a dangerous survival game. As they face nature's threats, their rivalry further complicates their fight to stay alive. Along with Shanaya Kapoor and Adarsh Gourav, the film also stars Parul Gulati, Amruta Khanvilkar, Kshitee Jog, Tanishq Shelare, Shrikant Yadav, and Rajendra Gupta. The film is a remake of the 2018 Thai movie *The Pool*.

Toxic Song Tabaahi Out: Yash, Kiara Advani Track Released Without Video, Fans React

Toxic first song *Tabaahi* starring Yash and Kiara Advani is out in multiple languages. Makers release audio without music video, fans react online.

Yash's much-anticipated film *Toxic: A Fairytale for Grown-Ups* has remained in headlines ever since its announcement. After teasing audiences with posters and glimpses from the film, the makers have now released the first single, *Tabaahi*, featuring Yash alongside Kiara Advani. However, the track's release has triggered mixed reactions online.

The song was launched in multiple languages, expanding its reach across markets. Vishal Mishra has composed the track, with lyrics adapted separately for each language — Raj Shekhar for Hindi, Yogenraj Bhat for Kannada, Ramajogayya Sastry for Telugu, Vignesh Shivan for Tamil, and Rafeeq Ahammed for Malayalam.

Despite the scale of the release, the makers chose to drop only the audio version, withholding the music video. This decision has left many fans disappointed, as they were hoping for fresh footage from the action-adventure through a full-fledged visual presentation.

The buzz around *Toxic* has steadily intensified with two teasers already unveiled. The first teaser highlighted the violent, blood-soaked world of the film, while the second offered a look at Yash in a striking beardless avatar. Reports suggest that the official trailer is slated to release on March 8, 2026.

The film carries enormous expectations as it



marks Yash's return to theatres four years after *KGF: Chapter 2*. In *Toxic*, he will be seen in dual roles as *Raya* and *Ticket*.

The ensemble cast includes Kiara Advani as *Nadia*, Nayanthara as *Ganga*, Huma Qureshi as *Elizabeth*, Tara Sutaria as *Rebecca*, Rukmini Vasanth as *Mellisa*, Tovino Thomas, Akshay Oberoi as *Tony*, Darrell D'Silva as *Salvador*, and Sudev Nair as *Karmadi*.

Directed by Geetu Mohandas, the film has been shot simultaneously in English and Kannada, with dubbed versions in Hindi, Tamil, Telugu and Malayalam. *Toxic: A Fairytale for Grown-Ups* is scheduled to release in cinemas on March 19, 2026, where it will clash at the box office with Aditya Dhar's *Dhurandhar 2: The Revenge*, headlined by Ranveer Singh.

Tiger was last seen in *Baaghi 4*, directed by A Harsha, which also starred Sanjay Dutt, Harnaaz Sandhu and Sonam Bajwa. The film did not perform as expected at the box office.
