


# LG Secretariat makes special arrangements for devotees on Tangpe Cho-nga

# LG Ladakh extends warm greetings on Holi



  - No Engineer or Gazettedrank or other Gazetted officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the State Government is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of two years after his retirement from Government service, without permission of the Government. The contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government as foresaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the Contractor's Service.
  - The contractor or intending bidder are advised to understand the nature of job advertised in E NIT. He may contact this office for any further discussion in case of a doubt.
  - No MSME exemptions are allowed.
  - If any, typographical error/ omission in respect of rate/ unit is found in the E NIT it shall be corrected as per sanctioned schedule of rates 2022.
  - Any item not included in the BOQ but found necessary during execution shall be carried out only with the prior written approval of the Engineer-in-Charge. Payment for such items shall be made at the rates of SSR 2022, adjusted by the overall depreciated rates quoted by the contractor. If the item is not available in the SSR, payment shall be made at analyzed market rates, duly approved by the competent authority.
  - The work identified for execution shall be started within 07 days from the date of allotment. Delay in completion of particular work within the stipulated period shall lead to imposition of penalty upto 10% of the allotted value of the work / Job depending upon the reasons given by Engineer Incharge
  - The accepting authority reserves the right of accepting or rejecting any or all e-tenders without assigning any reason.
  - Nothing extra shall be paid on the negotiated rates.
  - In case contractor fails to take up/ complete emergent/ urgent works in time, the same shall be got executed at the risk and cost of the contractor and the allotment may be terminated without any notice besides, the CDR shall be forfeited.   - To participate in bidding process, bidders have to get Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) as per information Technology Act-2000, to participate in online bidding. The certificate will be required for digitally signing the bid. Bidders can get above mentioned digital certificate from any approved vendors. The Bidders, who already possess valid (DSC) Digital Signature Certificate, need not to procure new Digital Signature Certificate.
  - The bidders have to submit their bids in online electronic format with Digital Signature. The bids cannot be uploaded without Digital Signature. No proposal will be accepted in physical form.
  - Before submission of online bids, bidders must ensure that scanned copies of all the necessary documents have been attached with bid.
  - The Department will not be responsible for delay in online submission of bids whatsoever reasons may be.
  - All the required information for bids must be filled and submitted online.
  - Bidders can contact the undersigned for any guidance for getting DSC or any other relevant details in respect of e-tendering process.
