

'I Haven't Gone Under The Knife': Avneet Kaur Breaks Silence On Plastic Surgery And Botox Rumours



Actress Avneet Kaur has often found herself in the spotlight, not just for her work but also for her evolving public image. She is quite active on social media and keeps treating fans with her glam pictures. Every now and then, her transformation keeps sparking widespread speculation, with many attributing her glow-up to Botox or other cosmetic procedures. stance. His note read, "I'd like to clarify that while clearing my feed, it appears the algorithm may have mistakenly registered an interaction. There was absolutely no intent behind it. I request that no unnecessary assumptions be made. Thank you for your understanding."

Avneet too had reacted to the controversy during her interaction with India Today. She had said, "I just keep working hard, that's what I am focused on, honestly. I just try to better myself in every aspect, not just acting. I try to focus on other things more, and I obviously never

Meghan Markle Opens Up On Challenges Of Royal Life, Says 'I Have Been Bullied And Attacked'

Prince Harry and his wife Meghan, Duchess of Sussex, opened up about the difficulties they faced as working royals on Thursday. Harry said he didn't want 'this job' after his mother died, and Meghan said she 'was the most trolled person in the entire world.' The couple made these comments during a four-day trip to Australia, where they are attending both public and commercial events.

At the InterEdge Summit in Melbourne, Harry talked about the grief he felt after losing his mother, Princess Diana, in a car crash when he was 12. He said, "After my mum died just before my 13th birthday, I was like: I don't want this job. I don't want this role - wherever this is headed, I don't like it." He explained that he struggled with his role for years but later realised he could use his position to make a difference.

Harry has often spoken about how his mother's death affected him and why he is protective of his wife and children. Six years ago, Harry and Meghan stepped down as working royals, later saying in interviews, a Netflix documentary, and a memoir that they left because of tabloid pressure, racism in British institutions, online abuse, family issues, and their wish for financial independence.

Meghan repeated on Thursday that online abuse had a big impact on her, saying, "Every day for 10 years, I have been bullied and attacked. And I was the most trolled person in the entire world, man or woman." She added, "Now, I'm still here," while speaking to young people from the Australian mental health group Batyr and discussing Australia's ban on social media for children under

Harry and Meghan's tour in Australia, which focuses on sports, mental health, and veterans, has received mixed reactions. Despite media reports suggesting the trip is for profit, it's not clear how much they will earn. Their tour is privately funded, Harry was not paid for his speech at the InterEdge Summit, and sources say rumours about Meghan getting a large payment for appearing on MasterChef Australia are false.

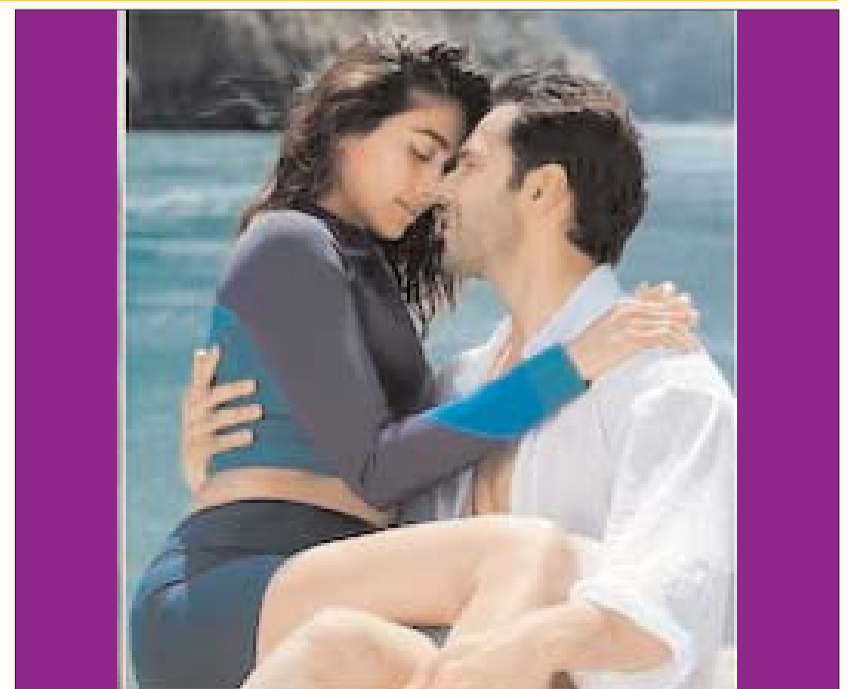
AI Babies In Varun Dhawan's Hai Jawani Toh Ishq Hona Hai Teaser Just A Gimmick? Here's The Truth

Hai Jawaani Toh Ishq Hona Hai's teaser was recently dropped, and the AI toddlers in the beginning of the Varun Dhawan, Pooja Hegde, and Mrunal Thakur starrer stirred quite a buzz. On April 14, the makers released the first glimpse of the film, which had social media users assuming that the movie might have some AI elements. However, a source has now shared that it was a trick to grab eyeballs.

As per a source quoted by Bollywood Hungama, "It was purely a gimmick to get people talking about the film's premise." The insider further added, "The makers wanted a quick, visually arresting way to set up the love triangle without revealing actual footage. AI babies were the pitch. It got greenlit for the teaser and stopped right there. There is no AI in the film."

Varun Dhawan, Mrunal Thakur, and Pooja Hegde's Hai Jawani Toh Ishq Hona Hai has been postponed. The film, which was earlier scheduled to release on June 5, will now hit theatres on June 12. The move came after Yash's Toxic changed its release date. The action drama has also shifted from March 19 to June 4.

In an official statement, Ramesh Taurani, Managing Director of Tips Films, shared, "We would like to clarify that our film - Hai Jawaani Toh Ishq Hona Hai was originally scheduled for release on June 5, a date we had announced several months ago. However, after recent developments and considering the prevailing situation, we felt it would be more appropriate to shift our release." He further added, "We strongly believe that it is always healthier for the industry when filmmakers support one another rather than compete unnecessarily on the same date. In that spirit of solidarity, we have decided to move the release of Hai Jawaani Toh Ishq Hona Hai to June 12 and bring our film to audi-



ences a week later."

Hai Jawaani Toh Ishq Hona Hai will face a box office clash with Imtiaz Ali's Main Vaapas Aunga, starring Diljit Dosanjh, Sharvari, and Vedang Raina, and Chand Mera Dil, featuring Lakshya and Ananya Panday, along with Anurag Kashyap's Bandar, starring Bobby Deol, and Milap Zaveri's Tera Yaar Hoon Main.
