

Raashii Khanna's Team Reacts to Rs 50,000 Theft Report, Denies Actor Was Targeted



Raashii Khanna has reportedly been at the centre of an unusual incident on a film set, where a member associated with her vanity van team was allegedly caught stealing money. However, conflicting claims have left the situation unclear.

According to reports, a person was caught stealing

₹50,000 from Raashii Khanna's vanity van, leading to a tense situation on set. The incident reportedly caused shock among those present, with security personnel intervening soon after.

It has been claimed that the accused individual was confronted and subsequently removed from the set. However, details around the incident remain uncertain, with multiple versions of events emerging.

While the report suggested the money belonged to the actor, Raashii Khanna has not issued an official statement on the matter. Her team, however, has denied the claims, stating that the cash in question belonged to her manager, not the actor herself.

The differing accounts have added to the confusion, and it remains unclear what exactly transpired.

On the work front, Raashii Khanna was last seen in the Telugu film *Ustaad* Bhagat Singh, alongside Pawan Kalyan and Sreeleela. While not the primary female lead, her role was described as significant within the narrative.

The film reportedly earned over ₹96 crore worldwide and is now available for streaming on Netflix.

The actor is currently working on her next project, which will be directed by Anees

Bazmee. The film is expected to star Akshay Kumar and Vidya Balan, and is reportedly titled *Ram Aur Shyam*, though an official confirmation is still awaited.

As of now, the alleged theft incident remains unverified, with no clear confirmation from Raashii Khanna or her team, leaving more questions than answers.

Karan Anshuman Reveals He Didn't Know About Jannat Zubair's Massive Following Before Glory

In an industry where popularity is often measured in numbers, casting decisions don't always follow the obvious path. Sometimes, it's not about followers or fame but about what an actor brings to the screen when it truly matters.

That seems to be the case with *Glory*, the upcoming Netflix sports drama that features Jannat Zubair Rahmani in a key role. The actor, who began her career as a child star, is returning to long-format storytelling after a gap of seven years. While her massive fanbase has been buzzing ever since the teaser dropped, the show's creator had a very different starting point when it came to casting her.

Speaking to *Hindustan Times* ahead of the trailer launch, showrunner Karan Anshuman shared that social media numbers played no role in the decision. "We don't cast because of social media numbers. That's not a thing. For us, it's always an audition. Can you do it? And the most deserving person who has the best audition wins the part. That's something we should be clear about."

Interestingly, Anshuman revealed that he had no idea about Jannat's massive online following—over 50 million on Instagram—when he first saw her audition. Known for her earlier work in projects like *Hichki* and TV shows such as *Phulwa* and *Bharat Ka Veer Putra – Maharana Pratap*, Jannat impressed him purely on performance. Recalling that moment, he said, "So, I saw (her audition), and I was like, 'Wow, this is great.' And then I was informed that she has an army of followers, and I thought, 'Okay, that's great. It's going to help the show'". But again, for me, that was not the important part. For me, it was about how she's going to be on set. It was a great audition to begin with," he says.

Despite being the youngest among the principal cast, Jannat seems to have held her own on set. Anshuman described their collaboration as mutually en-



riching, highlighting her confidence and clarity in approaching scenes. "What I found really fascinating working with her is the just the level of confidence this generation brings. Everyone from Suvinder Vicky to the other actors, if I had something to say to them, they would hear me out. But she always had her reasons, and it was always a discussion of how to approach a certain scene. Let me tell you, a lot of times she won out because I saw what she did and thought it worked for me. So, it was very much a learning experience for me as well, working with her. She's supremely talented and professional."

Glory blends sports drama with a mystery element, set against the backdrop of boxing in Haryana. The story follows two brothers, played by Pulkit Samrat and Divyendu, who return to their hometown after their sister—Jannat's character—meets with an accident. The ensemble also includes Suvinder Vicky, Sikandar Kher, Ashutosh Rana, and Sayani Gupta.
