

Director Horticulture Jammu conducts extensive tour of Samba district

Director Horticulture Jammu, Jenab Gul Syed, today undertook an extensive tour of District Samba to review ongoing horticulture activities and assess field-level implementation of departmental schemes.

During the visit, he was accompanied by Horticulture Development Officer, Purmandal, Sh. Rakesh Kumar, along with officials of Zone Purmandal. The Director inspected the orchard of Sh. Baloch Din at Village Bari, where he carried out an on-the-spot assessment of orchard management practices. He directed the officers and field staff to maintain regular interaction with farmers to ensure timely guidance and support.

Interacting with local farmers, the Director highlighted various government initiatives, including the Jammu and Kashmir Competitiveness Improvement Project (JKCIP), Holistic Agriculture Development Programme



(HADP), and Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH). He encouraged farmers to adopt high-value crops such as dragon fruit and diversify their cultivation practices to enhance income generation.

Later, Gul Syed visited a high-tech polyhouse at Village Badhori in Zone Purmandal, where he interacted with the beneficiary

and reviewed modern cultivation techniques being implemented under protected farming.

Emphasising the role of advanced technologies in horticulture, the Director stressed that adoption of innovative practices is key to improving productivity and strengthening the livelihoods of farmers across the region.

Ajatshatru mourns Udhampur Bus Tragedy

Senior BJP leader and former Minister Shri Ajatshatru Singh has expressed deep anguish and sorrow over the tragic bus accident in Udhampur district today, in which over 21 persons lost their lives and several others were critically injured when a passenger bus rolled down a hill near Kagort village in Ram Nagar area.

Shri Ajatshatru Singh, in a condolence statement, said that the news of this heart-wrenching tragedy has deeply saddened him. He prayed to the Almighty for peace to the departed souls and strength to the grief-stricken families to bear this irreparable loss.

The former minister urged the administration to ensure immediate and best possible medical treatment to all the injured and called for a thorough inquiry into the cause of the accident.

DC Budgam reviews Development Works at Doodhpathri

BUDGAM, APRIL 20: Deputy Commissioner (DC) Budgam, Athar Aamir Khan, today chaired a review meeting at TRC Tangnar, Doodhpathri to assess the progress and future roadmap for tourism development in the picturesque destination.

The meeting was attended by senior officers including CEO, Doodhpathri Development Authority (DDA), ACR Budgam, Superintending Engineer R&B, SDM Khansahib, JD planning Budgam, Divisional Forest Officer Budgam, Divisional Head Ecology & Environment Department and SHO Khansahab.

During the meeting, a detailed presentation highlighted the immense tourism potential of Doodhpathri, which is steadily emerging as a major eco-tourism and adventure destination. It was informed that the area has witnessed significant tourist footfall in recent years, with encouraging projections for further growth. The destination, located at an altitude of around 8960 feet, is known for its lush green meadows, scenic landscapes, rivers like Shaliganga and Sukhnag, and trekking routes connecting Tosamaidan, Yousmarg, and other high-altitude locations.

Vikramaditya condoles loss of lives in Udhampur Road mishap

In his condolence message, Shri Vikramaditya Singh said that the tragedy has left the entire region in a state of shock and mourning. He offered his heartfelt prayers for the souls of the deceased and conveyed deep sympathies to the bereaved families.

Congress Seva Dal demands high level probe into Udhampur road accident

Jammu Kashmir Congress Seva Dal President Vijay Sharma Babbi has expressed grief over the road accident in Ramnagar, Udhampur and has demanded investigation from the administration into the matter.

He said that more than a dozen people lost their lives while many people were injured in a road accident in Ramnagar on Monday morning.

Initial investigation suggests that the driver lost control at a sharp turn and the bus overturned. He said that such road accidents in hilly areas are not a new thing but the reasons are the same every time.

At some places the vehicles are not in good condition and at some places

they are loaded with more passengers than their capacity.

In the past too, these districts have faced dire situations, after which committees were formed by the police administration and checking campaigns were conducted, but after some time, the same situation is seen again. He said that just a few days ago a student died after falling from a college bus while going to Patnitop.

Today college students also demonstrated on this issue. He alleged that this accident happened due to the negligence of the driver. The police administration should take strict cognizance of such cases and run regular campaigns to check the fitness, licenses of drivers and other important documents of passenger vehicles plying in hilly and remote areas.

Goyal expressed grief over Udhampur road accident, demands probe

Rajkumar Goyal, National Executive President of Shri Amarnath Ji Yatra Welfare Society, has expressed grief over the horrific road accident that took place in Ramnagar in Udhampur district.

He expressed sympathy with the families of the deceased and wished for the speedy recovery of the injured.

Rajkumar Goyal said that a high level investigation should be conducted into this road accident so that it can be found out where the mistake happened.

Even before this, such horrific road accidents have occurred in Udhampur, Doda, Kisht-

war, Ramban, Rajouri, Poonch and other hilly districts.

In most of the cases, either the drivers were driving carelessly or the old buses had more passengers than their capacity.

The government will provide compensation to the dead and injured, but the loss suffered by the families cannot be compensated at all.

He urged the police department to keep a close watch on the vehicles plying in the hilly areas so that the cunning people do not play with the lives of the people. Apart from this, he has raised the demand to start a strict checking campaign by increasing the number of police personnel on these routes.
