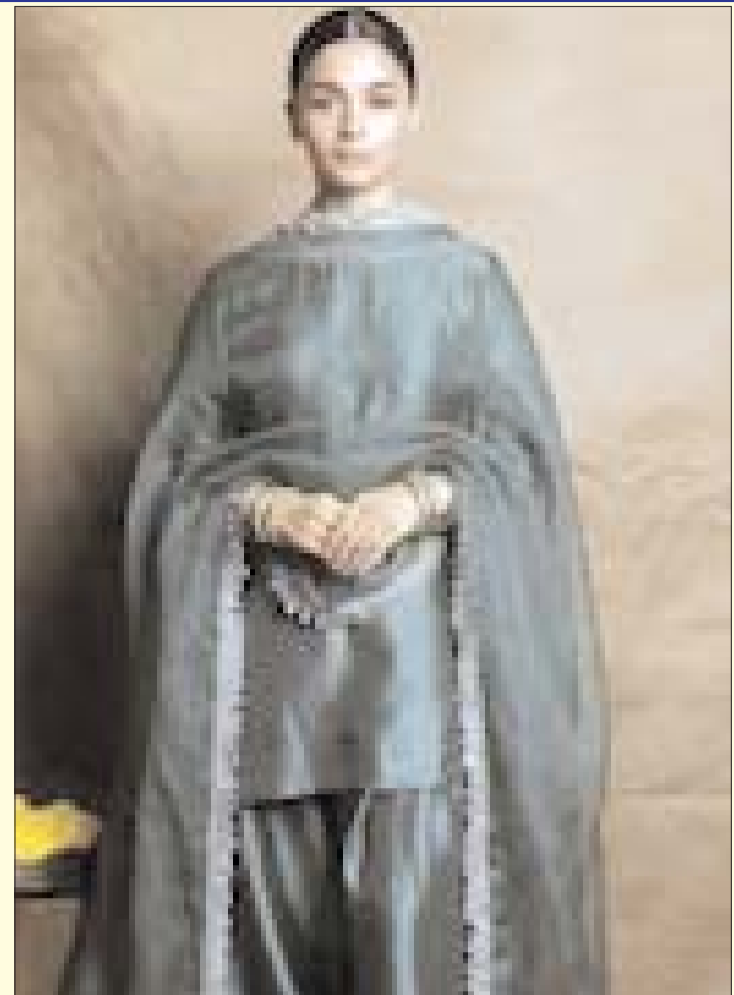

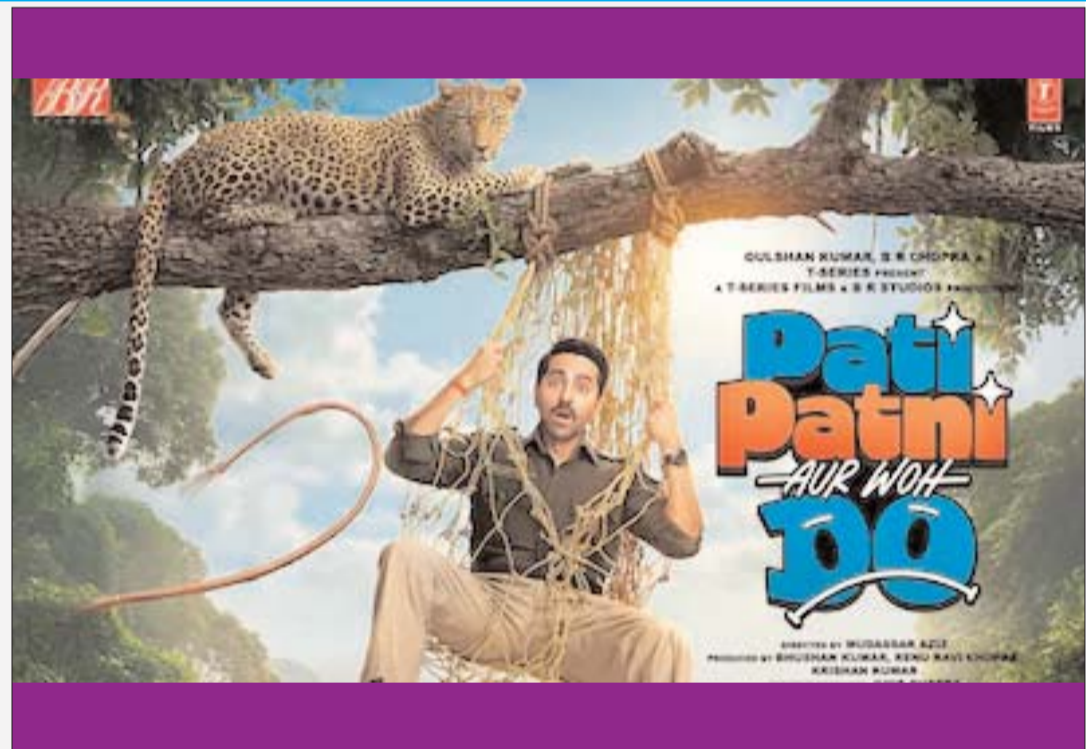

The teaser released today gave the audience a peek into the world of Prajapati Pandey, who finds himself caught between not one, not two, but three women, played by Sara Ali Khan, Wamiqa Gabbi, and Rakul Preet Singh. As the confusion snowballs into an all-out comedy of errors, Vijay Raaz enters as a cop, dialling up the chaos even further.

About *Pati Patni Aur Woh Do*

The comedy-drama, starring Ayushmann Khurrana, Sara Ali Khan, Rakul Preet Singh, and Wamiqa Gabbi, is the highly anticipated sequel to the 2019 film *Pati Patni Aur Woh*. Last year, the



makers revealed that the film would release in theatres on March 4, 2026, during Holi. However, the film's release has now been postponed. The makers have announced a new release date, sharing that *Pati Patni Aur Woh Do* will now hit theatres on May 15, 2026.

The film marks director Mudassar Aziz's return to the franchise after the first instalment, which featured Kartik Aaryan, Bhumi Pednekar, and Ananya Panday. This time, the story promises a fresh twist with a new ensemble and more outrageous comic situations. It is produced by T-Series' Bhushan Kumar along with B R Studios' Renu Ravi Chopra, with creative production led by Juno Chopra.

Hai Jawaani Toh Ishq Hona Hai Postponed
Meanwhile, Varun Dhawan, Mrunal Thakur, and Pooja Hegde's *Hai Jawaani Toh Ishq Hona Hai* has been postponed. The film, which was earlier scheduled to release on June 5, will now hit theatres on June 12. The move came after Yash's *Toxic* changed its release date. The action drama has also shifted from March 19 to June 4.

In an official statement, Ramesh Taurani, Managing Director of Tips Films, shared, "We would like to clarify that our film – *Hai Jawaani Toh Ishq Hona Hai* was originally scheduled for release on June 5, a date we had announced several months ago. However, after recent developments and considering the prevailing situation, we felt it would be more appropriate to shift our release."

He further added, "We strongly believe that it is always healthier for the industry when filmmakers support one another rather than compete unnecessarily on the same date. In that spirit of solidarity, we have decided to move the release of *Hai Jawaani Toh Ishq Hona*



Hai to June 12 and bring our film to audiences a week later."

However, the film will now clash at the box office with *Imtiaz Ali's Main Vaapas Aaunga*, starring Diljit Dosanjh, Sharvari and Vedang Raina.
