JKBOSE notifies dates for submission of Bi-Annual exam forms

The Jammu and Kashmir Board of School Education (JKBOSE) has notified the schedule for the submission of online permission cum examination forms for Class 10 and 12 Annual (Private)/Bi-Annual 2026 session.


The schedule applies to all eligible candidates across the UTs of J&K and Ladakh including both winter and summer zone areas. As per the notification, re-appear and failure candidates of class 10 can submit their examination forms in online mode whereas the fresh private candidates can submit

their forms in offline mode from April 27 to May 09 on payment of normal prescribed fee of Rs 1300 and with a late fee of Rs 2150 from May 11 to 16.

Likewise, re-appear and failure candidates of class 12 can submit their examination forms in online mode whereas the fresh private candidates can submit

their forms in offline mode from April 27 to May 09 on payment of normal prescribed fee of Rs 1510 and with a late fee of Rs 2360 from May 11 to 16.

- The electronic bidding system would not allow any latest submission of bids after due date and time as per server time. Bidders may modify their bids by uploading their request for modification before the deadline for submission of bids. For this, the bidder needs not to make any additional payment towards the cost of tender document. For bid modification and consequential re-submission, the bidder is not required to withdraw his bid submitted earlier. The last modified bid submitted by the bidder within the bid submission time shall be considered as the bid. For this purpose, modification/withdrawal by other means will not be accepted. In online system of bid submission, the modification and consequential-submission of bids is allowed any number of times. The bidders may withdraw his bid by uploading their request before the deadline for submission of bids; however, if the bid is withdrawn, the re-submission of the bid is not allowed. No bid shall be modified or withdrawn after the deadline of submission of bids.
