

BLBC Meeting held at Bandipora to review Financial Inclusion, Developmental Initiatives

Block Level Bankers Committee (BLBC) meeting was convened at Bandipora Block under the chairmanship of Lead District Officer, Shamim Ahmad Haji, to review implementation of government-sponsored schemes and measures aimed at strengthening financial inclusion and developmental activities in the area.

The meeting was attended by DDM NABARD, Rouf Ahmad, Cluster Head J&K Bank, Tanveer Ahmad, RBI representative, Anup, senior officers from various line departments and representatives of banking institutions operating across the district.

During the meeting, detailed deliberations were held regarding effective execution of government-sponsored schemes, augmentation of credit flow to priority sectors, strengthening of financial inclusion initiatives and promotion of sustainable self-employment opportunities for unemployed youth. Emphasis was also laid on dissemination of financial literacy and strengthening institutional coordination for ensuring inclusive socio-economic development.

The concerned depart-



ments presented a comprehensive review of the progress achieved under various welfare and developmental programmes. Banking officials furnished detailed assessments regarding loan disbursement, recovery performance and sector-wise credit deployment.

They also stressed the need for expeditious disposal of cases and enhanced coordination among departments for effective implementation of schemes.

The chair underscored the importance of proactive outreach programmes, timely sanctioning of financial assistance and intensified awareness campaigns, particularly in rural and underserved areas, to max-

imise developmental impact and public outreach.

Subsequently, the presiding officer, accompanied by officials from banks and line departments, conducted an extensive field visit to high-density orchard zones to assess developmental interventions being implemented at the grass-roots level.

During the visit, the delegation interacted with local farmers to evaluate accessibility of institutional credit, irrigation infrastructure, horticulture support services and implementation of agriculture and horticulture-related schemes. Farmers were also sensitised about the benefits of subsidised financial assistance and credit-linked

schemes for promotion of horticulture and allied sectors.

The visiting officials appreciated the progressive adoption of high-density plantation practices by growers and highlighted the importance of modern scientific and sustainable agricultural techniques for enhancing productivity, economic viability and long-term sustainability.

The meeting and field visit concluded with a reaffirmation by the concerned departments and banking institutions to strengthen coordination and extend continued support for holistic and sustainable developmental growth across the region.

100-Day Nasha Mukht Bharat Abhiyan intensified across Budgam

Various departments including Education, Health, Social Welfare, Police, Youth Services & Sports and other stakeholder agencies are jointly conducting awareness drives to sensitise youth about the harmful effects of substance abuse.

In continuation of the campaign activities, essay competition and debate programmes were today conducted at Government Higher Secondary School (GHSS) Budgam under the



National Mental Health & Behaviour Awareness (NMBA) programme. Students participated enthusiastically and expressed their ideas and awareness on important social and behavioural issues through creative writing and engaging discussions.

The activities were aimed at promoting awareness, critical thinking, effective communication and positive behavioural values among students while encouraging them to stay away from substance abuse and other harmful prac-

tices. Teachers and organisers appreciated the active involvement, creativity and confidence displayed by the participants during the programme.

The 100-day campaign focuses on preventive awareness, behavioural change, counselling support and community participation to effectively address the growing concern of drug abuse. Awareness rallies, seminars, interactive sessions and youth engagement programmes are also being organised across dif-

ferent areas of the district under the initiative.

The District Administration reiterated its commitment towards strengthening the objectives of the Nasha Mukht Bharat Abhiyan through coordinated efforts and sustained public participation.

Citizens, parents, educational institutions, religious leaders and civil society organisations have been urged to actively support the campaign and contribute towards making Budgam a drug-free district.

He also expressed satisfaction over the arrangements and the overall conduct of the training sessions and appreciated the efforts of the officers and staff involved in successfully organising the programme.

Maa Se Guftagu, 'Dosti Discussion' held at Naidkhai

BANDIPORA, MAY 13: Under the aegis of the Nasha Mukht Jammu and Kashmir Abhiyan (NMBA), the District Administration Bandipora on Wednesday organised a "Maa Se Guftagu" and "Dosti Discussion" programme at Government Higher Secondary School, Naidkhai, aimed at strengthening community participation in the district's sustained campaign against drug abuse.

The programme was attended by Anganwadi Workers and Helpers, students, faculty members, members of Mahila Samitis, ICDS officials, and local women from the area.

Addressing the gathering, the Deputy Commissioner Bandipora, Indu Kanwal



Chib, underscored the central role of mothers in shielding children from drug abuse and allied social evils. She observed that

mothers share the deepest bond with their children and are therefore uniquely positioned to contribute to character development, be-

havioural awareness, and the cultivation of open, trust-based relationships within the family.

Interacting with students, the Deputy Commissioner cautioned that drug abuse inflicts irreversible damage on an individual's health, dignity, career, and future prospects. She urged youth to stand firm against the growing menace rather than remain passive bystanders. She further informed that administration and enforcement agencies are actively working to dismantle drug supply networks, and that provisions of the COTPA Act and the Juvenile Justice Act are being enforced with particular vigilance in and around educational institutions.

The Deputy Commissioner advised mothers to remain alert to behavioural changes in their children, including shifts in friend circles and other early warning signs of substance abuse. She encouraged parents to invest quality time in their children's lives, engage them in prayers, sports, and constructive pursuits, and maintain close attention to their day-to-day activities and conduct.

Highlighting the broader social consequences of addiction, the Deputy Commissioner noted that a significant proportion of domestic violence cases in the district are linked to substance abuse.
