

L'Oréal Paris Calls Aishwarya Rai 'Living Legend' After Cannes Poster Snub: 'Year After Year...'



Aishwarya Rai was missing from L'Oréal Paris' latest Cannes Film Festival promotional posters, and fans immediately noticed. The actress, who has represented the beauty brand at Cannes for over two decades, was absent from a set of giant banners displayed at Le Martinez Hotel this week, sparking strong reactions online. The posters featured six L'Oréal ambassadors, including Alia Bhatt, but Aishwarya's absence quickly became a talking point among fans on Instagram.

For many fans, Aishwarya and Cannes have become almost inseparable over the years. So when L'Oréal Paris shared photos of its Cannes setup on Instagram

with the caption, "Consider this L'Oréal Paris's official check-in, Le Martinez is officially home for the Festival," people immediately began asking where Aishwarya was.

Several comments on the post questioned why the actress was not included in the campaign visuals despite being one of the brand's longest-serving ambassadors. One user wrote, "Waiting for Cannes Queen Aishwarya," while another commented, "It's too much! This time, L'Oréal is going overboard. The poster doesn't feature a legend like Aishwarya, who made the L'Oréal brand popular across the entire Asian continent, but instead highlights some actresses who are just two days old!" Another fan wrote, "Cannes is known for Aishwarya."
