

Miley Cyrus Gets Hollywood Walk Of Fame Star: 'I Hope I Continue To Affect Hearts'



Miley Cyrus has added another major milestone to her career, this time in the form of a permanent mark on Hollywood Boulevard. The singer and actor was officially honoured with a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame in the Recording category, drawing a crowd that included family, friends, and notable names from entertainment and fashion.

The ceremony comes at a particularly symbolic moment in her journey, arriving shortly after the 20th anniversary celebrations of Hannah Montana, the Disney series that first turned her into a global teen icon. The event saw appearances from actress Anya Taylor-Joy and designer Donatella Versace, who joined in celebrating Cyrus as she received one of Hollywood's most recognisable honours.

For the occasion, Cyrus opted for a sleek black gown and took to the stage to reflect on her artistic journey, including her 2025 track "Walk of Fame" from the album *Something Beautiful*. During her address, she also refer-

enced singer Brittany Howard's rendition of the lyric, "You'll live forever."

Sharing her thoughts on fame, time, and artistic urgency, Cyrus said, "Although I love the lyric, the fact I won't [live forever] is what creates the urgency that sets my heart on fire, my life and my art, and my desire to break down the walls of any boxes that we've been tricked to believe that exist."

She also recalled advice from her father, country musician Billy Ray Cyrus, linking it to both her career and the symbolism of the Walk of Fame itself. As reported by ABC, she said, "My dad used to say that a skyscraper starts with a jackhammer – so does a star on the Walk of Fame by the way – and it's not about the force, but it's about the repetition."

What feels so special to me about this star is that it's an accumulation of devotion."

Expanding further on what the honour represents to her, Cyrus highlighted that the star is not a traditional achievement marker but something more enduring and layered. She said, "The star isn't something that you win like a seasonal game. It's not something that you can chase or collect. It's not something you make the next record for, and then tote it around like a trophy."

She added, "After today, I commit to continuing the cycle full of creation, because that is what I truly live for. My hope is what I leave behind continues to affect the hearts of generations to come, ones that I won't be here to experience. I hope it awakens something raw and imperfect and sexy and glamorous and joyful in times that need it."

The moment was also a family affair, with Cyrus acknowledging her supporters from both sides of her personal life. She thanked her mother Tish Cyrus, sister Brandi Cyrus, and also mentioned her fiancé Maxx Morando, who attended the ceremony with his parents.

Speaking about the honour, Ana Martinez, producer of the Walk of Fame ceremonies, said, "The Hollywood Chamber of Commerce is proud to welcome singer Miley Cyrus to the Hollywood Walk of Fame," adding, "Miley deserves her flowers as she has made a lasting impact on the entertainment industry, and we are thrilled to honor her with a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame."

Mahesh Babu, SS Rajamouli Shoot Crucial Song For Varanasi, Shoot To Wrap Up In August: Report



The buzz surrounding *Varanasi* continues to grow as fresh updates about the ambitious project starring Mahesh Babu and directed by S. S. Rajamouli have surfaced online. According to reports, the team is currently filming a crucial song sequence for the movie on a grand set erected in Hyderabad.

According to Telugu Chitraalu report, Mahesh Babu and director SS Rajamouli are currently shooting a song sequence for *Varanasi*. Reportedly, the superstar has been filming on a massive set in Katedan, Hyderabad. The report further says that the makers are aiming to wrap up the entire shoot for *Varanasi* by the end of August 2026.

Mahesh Babu Had To Change THESE Things About Himself To Play Lord Ram

Mahesh Babu plays Lord Ram in the film, and his character is called Rudhra. In a recent chat with Screen Rant Plus, he spoke about Rajamouli's method

of filmmaking, while also talking about what it's like to play Lord Ram. Mahesh Babu said, "He (SS Rajamouli) has a process. There's a method to it. So when I was, for instance, I play Lord Ram in this film, and so when you're playing that character... so it's very important that your posture has to be, you know, you have to get it right the way your character walks, the way he stands."

The actor added, "He wanted to nail that, and so the whole of last year I was prepping for that for 2 months or 3 months, you know, we had to go take kalari classes. Kalari is a very intense form... Kerala form of martial arts... When you go through that, your body opens up, and it's very easy to get into these postures."

According to a report by Bollywood Hungama, the

upcoming epic action-adventure could be split into two films to accommodate its expansive narrative. The decision, if finalised, mirrors a storytelling approach that Rajamouli successfully executed with *Baahubali*, which changed the dynamics of large-scale filmmaking in India and paved the way for multi-part franchise films.

A source familiar with the development told the publication, "Three hours-plus would not be enough for *Varanasi*. They are looking at extending it into a two-part format," adding, "Rajamouli and his team feel this extended format would afford them the liberty to tell a more expanded story without looking anxiously at the clock."

The film features Mahesh Babu, Priyanka Chopra and Prithviraj Sukumaran in lead roles and is being mounted on a large scale.

Suriya Reacts To Karuppu Sequel Buzz, Says 'Belief Is Life' Amid Film's Box Office Success

Suriya and Trisha Krishnan-starrer *Karuppu* hit theatres on May 15, 2026, and has been enjoying a strong run at the box office. Directed by RJ Balaji, the fantasy action drama has struck a chord with audiences, and amid its success, Suriya has now reacted to the possibility of a sequel.

Is *Karuppu 2* Happening?

Suriya recently attended a fan meet-and-greet event following the overwhelming response to *Karuppu*. During the interaction, the actor was asked whether a sequel to the film had been confirmed.

Responding to the question, Suriya said, "Nambikai thaana sir vazhakai," which translates to "Belief is life, sir."

His cryptic yet hopeful response has sparked excitement among fans, especially since the film's success has already led to speculation about a second part. Interestingly, director RJ Balaji had also confirmed during a recent media interaction that a sequel is indeed being planned.

Suriya Says He Signed *Karuppu* In 30-45 Minutes

At the event, Suriya also revealed that he agreed to do *Karuppu* almost immediately after hearing the narration. Calling it a rare decision in his recent career, the actor shared that he signed the project within half an hour.

He said, "Karuppu was decided in 30-45 minutes. I've never signed a film that quickly in recent times. I've also never seen this kind of response for my films in recent years. It's receiving unanimous love worldwide. Thank you, everybody."

The actor further opened up about the film's climax dance sequence and revealed that it was added after the final edit had already been locked.

Suriya said, "The *Karuppu* climax was shot after the edit was locked five months ago. Even after filming was completed, one of the assistants suggested adding a song dedicated to Karuppusamy despite the financial hurdles."

About *Karuppu*



Karuppu begins with the story of a father and daughter who travel to Chennai for the daughter's surgery. At a railway station during the night, the two are robbed of the gold they had planned to sell in order to pay for her medical treatment.

Although the gold is eventually recovered, the father and daughter are forced to face a network of corrupt forces led by a lawyer named Baby Kannan. With no one left to turn to, the father prays to the guardian deity Karuppusamy, who then takes human form to help them and reform the system.

The film ends with an epilogue teasing a sequel titled *Karuppu vs Vellai*, adding further weight to speculation about the franchise continuing.

Apart from Suriya and Trisha Krishnan, *Karuppu* also stars RJ Balaji, Indrans, Anagha Maya Ravi, Natarajan Subramaniam, Swasika, Sshivada and others in key roles.

Trisha Krishnan Reacts To Being The 'Common Factor' In Vijay, Suriya, And Ajith Kumar's Highest-Grossers

actor Trisha Krishnan has been enjoying the success of her recently released film *Karuppu*, and now the actress has reacted to being the common factor in Vijay, Suriya, and Ajith Kumar's highest-grossing films. Vijay, Suriya, and Ajith are considered three of the biggest actors in Tamil cinema, and coincidence has it that leading lady Trisha has been a part of their highest grossers of all time.

In 2023, Vijay got his highest-grossing film with *Leo*, directed by Lokesh Kanagaraj, which collected ₹605.90 crore worldwide and starred Trisha in the lead role. Despite mixed reviews, the

fantasy courtroom drama turned into a commercial success and is now the highest-grossing Tamil film of 2026. *Karuppu* stars Suriya alongside Trisha Krishnan and RJ Balaji. The cast also includes Indrans, Anagha Maya Ravi, Natty Subramaniam, Swasika, Sshivada, and Supreeth Reddy.

The film follows Karuppusamy, who disguises himself as Advocate Saravanan to fight against a corrupt legal system. At the success meet, Suriya also hinted at the possibility of expanding the *Karuppu* universe further, though no official sequel announcement has been made yet.
