

Shakti Shalini: Climax Of Aneet Padda Film Leaked? Viral Video Of Woman Dragging Man Leaves Fans Excited



A video claimed to be leaked footage from the sets of Shakti Shalini has gone viral on social media, giving fans a possible glimpse into Aneet Padda's upcoming film from the Maddock Horror Comedy Universe. The film, directed by Aditya Sarpotdar, reportedly wrapped up shooting recently. While the makers have not confirmed the authenticity of the clip, it has already sparked discussion online among fans eagerly waiting for the movie's release.

In the viral video on X, a young woman can be seen dragging a man before tying his leg to a rope attached to a horse. The short clip has led to speculation about Aneet's character and the film's storyline, with many wondering whether the scene offers a hint about the powerful role teased in the film's announcement.

Interestingly, Mid-day reported that on May 27, direc-

tor Aditya Sarpotdar wrapped the horror comedy at Chitrarth Studio in Powai, where they filmed an elaborate sequence that sees the celebration of the protagonist's victory over evil. About the last day of the shoot, a source shared, "Massive sets depicting a Rajasthan village and the interiors of a house were built. The sequence shows the village people, especially women, celebrating the defeat of evil."

The footage drew positive reactions from fans, many of whom expressed excitement about the character's fierce and action-oriented side. One fan commented, "The film looks like it will be great and enjoyable, I just hope the visual effects aren't overdone, and we will see a masterpiece."

Another wrote, "Leaked scene from shakti shalini oh GOD is this shakti or shalini and wdyw she will go around beating and killing men yesssss bbg."

A third fan posted, "Aneet Padda beating criminals and terrible men!! My favorite genre."

Shakti Shalini was officially announced during Diwali last year. The title announcement promo was attached to Thamaa and introduced the central character with the descriptions: "The Protector", "The Destroyer", and "The Mother Of All".

The film marks another chapter in the expanding Maddock Horror Comedy Universe, which includes several interconnected titles that have found success at the box office.

Apart from Aneet Padda, the film also features Nana Patekar, Vineet Kumar Singh and Vishal Jethwa in key roles.

Shakti Shalini is currently scheduled for a Christmas 2026 release. The film is also expected to arrive around the same time as Shah Rukh Khan's King.

Now, a publicist, in a recent interview, revealed that the image of Emraan Hashmi that was created was nothing but a carefully planned marketing strategy during his early years in Bollywood.

In a recent podcast, Soha Ali Khan invited PR professional Parul Gossain, who shared how the Aashiq Banaya Aapne actor's 'serial kisser' image came to life. She shared, "There was Emraan Hashmi. He has no interest in PR. I remember Mahesh Bhatt saying that we have to do PR for him now. I told him that all his stories about kissing girls always get picked up.
