Problems faced by common man.

Mr Sharma said that people are suffering due to unprecedented price hike, large scale unemployment and joblessness besides the water scarcity due to failure & non completion of Jal Jeevan Mission schemes.

The ban on issuance of land fards, a mandatory document for land transfers due to non availability of Mosavi in most parts, has badly hit the needy people for treatment of life consuming diseases, seeking loans and availing government facilities. Addressing a meeting of party workers at Dharamsal Mr Sharma said that people are suffering on various counts due to neglect of genuine needs of people of different areas.

He said that Congress-NC government had sanctioned a tehsil and block status besides grant of higher secondary school in Dharamsal area, however after the change of government in 2014, these facilities



were withdrawn by BJP government and UT administration to the disadvantage of people.

Seeking reconsideration of decision to cancel these facilities, Mr. Sharma said that students have to travel 8 to 10 kms distance after tenth class to get 10 plus 2 schooling. He asked the government to upgrade the high school Dharamsal to 10+2 levels at the earliest.

Senior Congress leader also interacted with party workers at Souli and Kalakote and assured to highlight their genuine issues at different levels of water scarcity due to non completion of JJM schemes

besides seeking expeditious ongoing house committee investigations into multiple failures and scams in JJM.

He asked party cadres to strengthen the organization at grass root levels. Several prominent persons desired to join. Congress party in the coming days.

Earlier former MLC visited Chowki Handan, Bagnoti and Lamberi in Nowshera and interacted with the people. He also attended a mega blood donations camp at Chowki Handan organised by Sant Nirankari Sanstha and appreciated the mission for the yeoman services to the society.

MLA launches 'Khet Bachao Abhiyan' at Purkhoo; Calls Youth to Lead Farmer Awareness Movement

Hon'ble MLA Jammu North, Shri Sham Lal Sharma, today formally launched the month-long Khet Bachao Abhiyan at Village Purkhoo in Sub-Division Marh during a farmers awareness programme organized by the Department of Agriculture Production & Farmers Welfare, Jammu.

The programme was attended by Joint Director Agriculture (Farms/SLUB), Shri Aman Jyoti Sharma; District Agriculture Officer Jammu, Shri Vinod Khajuria; SMS (DL), Shri Sham Khajuria; and Sub-Divisional Agriculture Officer (SDAO) Marh, Shri Khalid Hassan Tantray, along with officers and field functionaries of the department.

More than 300 farmers, members of Youth Clubs under JKPCIP, NATS Krishi Veers, Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs), and Self-Help Groups (SHGs) participated enthusiastically in the campaign. Prominent youth clubs, including Baba Birfa Nath Youth Club Kanger, Ganpati Youth Club Ghainik, Eco Warrior Youth Club Purkhoo, and Jai Shiv Shanker Youth Club Bhalwal, actively participated in the programme.

Addressing the gathering, Shri Sham Lal Sharma emphasized that youth are the future of the nation and have a pivotal role in transforming the agricultural sector. He appreciated the youth clubs being promoted and supported by the Agriculture Department Jammu and called upon them to actively visit villages and create awareness among farmers regarding modern, scientific, and sustainable agricultural practices.

He stressed that the "Khet Bachao Abhiyan" should



not remain merely an awareness programme but should evolve into a comprehensive mass movement connecting farms, farmers, and villages. He said that the campaign aims to protect agricultural land, reduce cultivation costs, and ensure timely, need-based technical guidance to farmers through direct field-level interactions.

The MLA further highlighted that minimizing the indiscriminate use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides would be one of the key objectives of the campaign. Farmers would be sensitized about the balanced use of fertilizers and other agricultural inputs based on soil testing. He emphasized that special efforts would be made to motivate farmers to adopt green manures, organic inputs, and bio-products for improving soil health and ensuring long-term agricultural sustainability.

Shri Sham Lal Sharma also emphasized the importance of educating farmers about the benefits of Natural Farming and other sustainable agricultural practices. He further stated that greater area coverage should be achieved under the Mission on Aatmanirbharta in Pulses and the National Mission on Edible Oils in the Jammu region.
