Hopes weren't too high when I entered the theatre to watch Hai Jawani Toh Ishq Hona Hai, but I must admit, the film is much better than expected. It's fun.

Directed by David Dhawan, Hai Jawani Toh Ishq Hona Hai stars Varun Dhawan, Mrunal Thakur and Pooja Hegde in the lead. The film revolves around a man who finds himself in a situation when he discovers that both his wife and girlfriend are pregnant at the same time. What follows is a roller-coaster ride and entertainment.

To begin with, Hai Jawani Toh Ishq Hona Hai is a typical David Dhawan movie. The director returns to his comfort zone with this film and the result is exactly what fans of his cinema would expect: a light-hearted entertainer packed with confusion, comedy and romance. The film does not attempt to reinvent the wheel, but it succeeds in delivering wholesome family entertainment.

The plot of the film is nothing extraordinary, nor does it offer anything great to the audience. But that is precisely where the film's charm lies. It embraces its old-school Bollywood roots without hesitation and focuses entirely on one thing: How to keep the audience entertained.

The first half of the film is terribly weak. The film struggles to find its footing in the initial hour. The makers make desperate attempts to make people laugh with dialogues which often sound cringeworthy rather than entertaining. However, several of these jokes just fail to land. The narrative feels stretched and the humour of ten comes across as forced, making portions of



the opening act frustrating to sit through.

However, it is the second half of the movie that saves it. The film undergoes a noticeable transformation after the interval. The second half is significantly sharper, funnier and far more engaging. The comic situations become more organic, the characters click better and the jokes finally start working. This is where David Dhawan's expertise shines, turning the film into an enjoyable laugh riot.

It should also be noted that David Dhawan has used several old songs in his movie. Luckily, it becomes one of the highlights of the film. Rather than feeling forced, the nostalgic tracks blend seamlessly with the film's mood and enhance the entertainment factor.

As far as performances are concerned, Varun Dhawan once again proves why comedy remains his strongest genre. The actor appears completely at ease and delivers a performance full of energy and charm.

Why Rosalia Postponed Her Florida Concerts Ahead Of North American Tour Launch

Fans looking forward to seeing Rosalia kick off the next phase of her world tour in the United States will have to wait a little longer. The Spanish singer has unexpectedly put several upcoming performances on hold, leaving ticket holders awaiting further updates.

According to announcements from venue officials and tour organizers, Rosalia has postponed three scheduled concerts in Florida because of a family emergency. The affected shows include two dates at Miami's Kaseya Center on June 4 and June 6, along with a June 8 performance at Orlando's Kia Center.

A statement shared by Kaseya Center on June 4 explained the reason behind the decision. "She is sorry to disappoint her fans, but the circumstances have left her with no other choice," the statement said.

Live Nation later confirmed that the Orlando concert had also been postponed. No additional information regarding the family emergency has been made public.

Organisers have advised fans not to discard their tickets while efforts are underway to find new dates for the affected shows.

"As the tour explores rescheduling, please hold onto your ticket," the statement read. "We will provide more information soon. Thank you for your patience."



The postponed dates were expected to launch the North American leg of Rosalia's LUX Tour, her fourth major concert tour. The global outing supports her fourth studio album, LUX, which was released in November 2025.

The tour began in Lyon, France, on March 16 and is currently slated to wrap up in San Juan, Puerto Rico, on September 3. Since its start, the concert series has attracted strong attendance across Europe and Latin America.

For now, fans are awaiting fresh scheduling details as organizers work on revised plans for the Florida shows.

Ranbir Kapoor-Alia Bhatt Shot A 'Magical' Piece For Love & War: 'When You See It...'

Choreographer Vijay Ganguly is currently enjoying the success of Dhurandhar, especially after the song "Shararat" became one of the film's biggest talking points. While appreciation continues to pour in for his work, Ganguly already has a packed slate ahead, including Sanjay Leela Bhansali's much-awaited Love & War, starring Ranbir Kapoor, Alia Bhatt and Vicky Kaushal.

He said, "He's someone who will give you everything that you need. If I need five days, he will

let me take six. So it's like you get everything with him. And creatively, he is involved in every small little process. So it's just a dream to work with someone like that."

Vijay Ganguly On Working With Yash Raj Films

During the same interview, Ganguly revealed that he is also working on two major Yash Raj Films projects. These include the upcoming spy action thriller Alpha, starring Alia Bhatt and Sharvari, and Ahaan Panday's next film, directed by Ali Abbas Zafar.

Speaking about his equation with YRF, Ganguly praised Aditya Chopra for his sharp creative inputs across films.

He said, "Aditya Chopra is involved in every film, including Ahaan's upcoming project. He's someone I always turn to and ask, 'Aditya sir, watch what we've done and tell us what you feel.' What he brings is incredible clarity. He'll point out something very specific, sometimes even a single word or movement and suggest a completely different way of approaching it. Those insights often elevate the work and help make it stronger."
