- Bids must be accompanied with cost of Tender document in shape of e-challan through Treasury indicating Treasury Voucher No. & date, e-NIT No. and name of work duly crediting to M/I 0059 (Revenue) favouring Executive Engineer PWD (R&B) Project Division III, Jammu and upload the same i.e treasury challan / receipt, Earnest Money/Bid security in shape of CDR/FDR/BG pledged to Executive Engineer PWD (R&B) Project Division III, Jammu. The date of both should be in between publishing and closing of NIT. The CDR/FDR/BG shall be valid for 45 Days beyond the bid validity period. The original instruments in respect of cost of documents, EMD and relevant documents of L1 be submitted to the Executive Engineer PWD (R&B) Project Division III, Jammu within 03(three) days after the issuance of the Letter of Acceptance.
- The electronic bidding system would not allow any late submission of bids after due date and time as per server time. Bidders may modify their bids by uploading their request for modification before the deadline for submission of bids. For this, the bidder needs not to make any additional payment towards the cost of tender document. For bid modification and consequential re-submission, the bidder is not required to withdraw his bid submitted earlier. The last modified bid submitted by the bidder within the bid submission time shall be considered as the bid. For this purpose, modification/withdrawal by other means will not be accepted. In online system of bid submission, the modification and consequential submission of bids is allowed any number of times. The bidders may withdraw his bid by uploading their request before the deadline for submission of bids; however, if the bid is withdrawn, the re-submission of the bid is not allowed. No bid shall be modified or withdrawn after the deadline of submission of bids.
- The date and time of opening of Financial-Bids shall be notified on Web Site [www.jktenders.gov.in](http://www.jktenders.gov.in) and conveyed to the bidders automatically through an e-mail message on their e-mail address. The Financial-bids of responsive bidders shall be opened online in the Office of Executive Engineer PWD (R&B) Project Division III, Jammu. The date for same shall be intimated separately.
- The bids for the work shall remain valid for a period of 120 days from the date of opening of Technical bids.

- To participate in bidding process, bidders have to get "Digital Signature Certificate (DSC)" as per Information Technology Act-2000. Bidders can get digital certificate from any approved vendors.
- The bidders have to submit their bids online in electronic format with digital Signature. No financial bid will be accepted in physical form.
- Bids will be opened online as per time schedule mentioned above or on the next working day if the mentioned date happens to be a holiday.

# CPCO Amit Reviews Baramulla's Preparedness for Census 2027

Chief Principal Census Officer (CPCO) and Director Census Operations (DCO), Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, Amit Sharma, along with Principal Census Officer-cum-Deputy Commissioner Baramulla, Syed Fakhruddin Ahmad, chaired a review meeting at Dak Bungalow Baramulla to assess preparedness and progress of the ongoing House Listing Operations (HLO) being conducted from June 1 to June 30, 2026, as part of the Census exercise.

Addressing a large gathering of enumerators and supervisors, Amit Sharma highlighted the significance of the Census as the country's largest administrative and statistical exercise and emphasized its crucial role in planning, governance and socio-economic development. He also briefed media representatives about the objectives, methodology and key features of Census 2027.

Appreciating the level of preparedness in Baramulla district, the CPCO said the Census would be conducted in a systematic and scientific manner through designated enumerators and supervisors. He elaborated on various aspects of the enumeration process, including household listing, collection of demographic and socio-economic data, use of digital technology and measures being adopted to ensure accuracy, transparency and confidentiality during the exercise.

Amit Sharma informed that citizens can contact the dedicated toll-free helpline



number 1855 for any query or clarification related to Census 2027 in the district. He appealed to the public to extend full cooperation to census officials and provide accurate information during the enumeration process, stating that active public participation is essential for generating reliable data for informed policymaking and development planning.

Deputy Commissioner Baramulla Syed Fakhruddin Ahmad informed the meeting that all necessary administrative and logistical arrangements have been put in place to ensure smooth conduct of Census-related activities across the district. He stressed the importance of coordinated efforts among all stakeholders and reiterated the district administration's commitment towards comprehensive coverage and high-quality data collection.

The meeting featured detailed discussions and brainstorming sessions focusing on ensuring coverage of all households, including migratory populations, and strengthening field-level census operations across the district.

The CPCO appreciated the dedicated efforts of field staff and urged enumerators and supervisors to perform their duties with commitment and professionalism. He emphasized effective coordination among census functionaries, timely data collection and strict adherence to census guidelines to ensure accuracy and completeness of the exercise.

Joint Chief Principal Census Officer Arun Kumar also briefed participants on the monitoring framework for field operations and stressed the importance of real-time tracking and supervision of data collection activities.

Among others, Additional Deputy Commissioner Baramulla, Assistant Commissioner Revenue (ACR), all SDMs, Charge Officers, Assistant Chief Principal Census Officer, District Coordinator for Census 2027 Baramulla and other concerned officers and officials attended the meeting.
