What Is Avatar: Fire And Ash About?

In Avatar: Fire And Ash, Jake Sully and his family are still dealing with the grief of losing their child. Their fragile peace is disturbed when they come across the Ash People, a hostile Na'vi clan that worships fire and believes it has been abandoned by its goddess.

As this new clan emerges as a dangerous force, the Sully family must fight to survive yet another threat. At the same time, the return of human ag-



gressors intensifies the larger conflict between the Na'vi and colonisers.

The film not only deepens the emotional stakes for Jake and Neytiri but also introduces new cultures, landscapes and ecosystems within Pandora, adding fresh layers to Cameron's expansive sci-fi universe.

Avatar: Fire And Ash Cast

The film features the return of Sam Worthington as Jake Sully and Zoe Saldana as Neytiri. The cast also includes Sigourney Weaver, Stephen Lang and Kate Winslet, who reprise their roles from the earlier films.

New and returning cast members include Oona Chaplin as Varang, Cliff Curtis as Tonowari, Joel David Moore as Dr Norm Spellman and David Thewlis as Peylak, among others.

With its spectacular visuals, emotional family drama and expansion of Pandora's mythology, Avatar: Fire And Ash is expected to attract strong viewership when it begins streaming on JioHotstar from June 24.

Ram Charan Shouted At Peddi Makers Over Janhvi Kapoor's 'B**b And Waist Shots': Actress In Leaked Chats

Janhvi Kapoor allegedly praised Ram Charan for standing up for her during the filming of Peddi, according to leaked chats that surfaced online amid the ongoing controversy surrounding her portrayal in the film. The alleged chats were leaked by a fan page days after Peddi drew massive backlash from a section of viewers over the portrayal and oversexualisation of Janhvi's character, Achyyamma.

The screenshots, whose authenticity News18 could not independently verify, seem to show Janhvi discussing her discomfort with certain shots being filmed and claiming that Ram Charan intervened after she raised concerns.

Ram Charan Came to Janhvi Kapoor's Rescue One screenshot, reportedly from October last year, shows Janhvi objecting to specific camera angles. "I told him no b**b and waist shots (sic)," the message reads.

The actor then seemingly credited Ram Charan for backing her position. In one message, she wrote, "And Ram sir is so sweet. He also yelled at him and said, 'You will not take such angles of her ever again.' So he got upset (sic)."

In another exchange, Janhvi had even stronger words for her co-star. "Like the best man in this whole industry, I swear," she allegedly wrote while discussing the incident.

When a fan compared the situation to criticism around Kiara Advani's scenes in Game Changer, Janhvi allegedly reacted, "No, in this what they were taking was worse. But Ram sir said no way, stop (sic)."

Another message spoke of her concerns about trust and creative control on film sets. Reacting to worries about body doubles, Janhvi allegedly wrote, "Ya I've said this but you know how it is here. They'll say close up and put camera on your cleavage. U can't trust anything (sic)."

Peddi director Buchi Babu Sana also reacted to the backlash. In an interview with SCREEN, the filmmaker argued that while they wanted to present a 'playful romance' between Janhvi and Ram Charan in the movie, the final scenes did not come out as intended. "I had not anticipated that the scenes would be perceived so negatively by audiences," Buchi said and added, "The idea was to showcase a playful romance story between Ram Charan and Janhvi Kapoor."

Kangana Ranaut On Playing Nurse In Bharat Bhhagya Viddhaata: 'The Profession Is Sexualised'

Kangana Ranaut has criticised the way nursing is often perceived in society, saying the profession is frequently "sexualised" and stereotyped despite nurses being among the most important frontline workers in healthcare.

The actor-politician, who will next be seen in Bharat Bhhagya Viddhaata, spoke about the issue while discussing her upcoming film, which is inspired by the true story of the brave staff of Mumbai's Cama Hospital during the 26/11 terror attacks. Kangana said the film aims to shift public perception and bring dignity and recognition to nurses, ward boys and other hospital workers who often remain invisible despite their vital contribution.

In an exclusive conversation with ANI, Kangana said, "Badlaav hona chahiye logon ke jo bhaav hai unke liye usme badlaav hona chahiye. I think it is the most sexualised profession." Speaking about the challenges nurses face, Kangana said the profession is often underpaid, overworked and underappreciated,



even though nurses handle some of the most demanding responsibilities inside hospitals.

She also referred to a dialogue from Bharat Bhhagya Viddhaata to highlight how society casually looks at nurses.

She shared, "Humari film mein dialogue bhi hai ki do log nurse

ko dekhkar time mila to do chaar baatein bhi kar lo. That is the reality."

Kangana added that nurses deserve far more respect for the work they do every day.

She said, "We don't give them the respect they deserve. Nurses do a lot of important work, from

cleaning patients to ensuring the hospital functions smoothly. If our perspective changes because of this film, even for a few minutes, it will be meaningful."

Kangana Ranaut On Forgotten Frontline Workers

The actress further said that whenever people think of hospitals, they usually think of doctors first, while the contribution of nurses, ward boys, watchmen and support staff often goes unnoticed.

She said, "When we think about hospitals, we naturally think of doctors, and their contribution is immense. But why don't we pause and think about the millions of workers who keep the system running every day?"

Kangana also spoke about the courage shown by the staff of Cama Hospital during the 26/11 Mumbai terror attacks. She said many of them played a crucial role as witnesses in identifying the terrorists.

She shared, "People will be surprised to know that they were the key witnesses in identifying Ajmal Kasab."
