

ADDC Kathua reviews progress under Mission YUVA

KATHUA, JUNE 10: Additional District Development Commissioner Kathua Surinder Mohan Sharma today chaired a review meeting of officers concerned to assess progress under Mission

YUVA in the district. At the outset, Assistant Director District Employment and Counselling Centre (DECC) Kathua Piyusha Khajuria briefed the meeting on student mobilisation in colleges and through Self

Help Groups, status of application sanctioning, output tracking, capacity-building initiatives, entrepreneurship mentorship, onboarding of stakeholders on the ONDC platform and staff hiring.

The meeting was informed that 114 training batches comprising 925 aspirants have completed training under the Mission. Further, 20 industries have been onboarded, 14 aspirants have received training certificates in five batches and 28 shops and establishments have been onboarded on the ONDC platform.

Reviewing the progress, the ADDC directed the banks concerned to expedite sanctioning of eligible applications and ensure timely disposal of pending cases. He also instructed Additional Deputy Commissioners and Sub-Divisional Magistrates to closely monitor implementation of the Mission in their respective jurisdictions and submit regular progress reports.

The ADDC further directed college representatives to consolidate registrations of eligible students under Mission YUVA and intensify awareness and mobilisation efforts to ensure maximum participation of youth in the programme.

BIS organises 'Manak Samvaad' for Newly Granted Licensees

The Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), Jammu & Kashmir Branch Office (JKBO), organized a "Manak Samvaad" programme for newly granted BIS licensees at its Jammu office on Wednesday. More than 18 representatives from newly certified industries and establishments from Jammu & Kashmir, Pathankot and Gurdaspur participated in the programme.

The programme was conducted for licensees who obtained BIS Certification during the period from December 18, 2025 to May 31, 2026. The initiative aimed at familiarizing newly granted license holders with BIS certification requirements, compliance obligations, surveillance procedures, marking and labelling norms, renewal

procedures and various services offered by BIS. Welcoming the participants, Ashish Kumar Dwivedi, Standard Promotion Officer, BIS-JKBO, congratulated the newly granted licensees on becoming part of India's quality ecosystem and emphasized their role in ensuring the availability of quality products conforming to Indian Standards.

Addressing the gathering, Jeevanandam D, Scientist-E/Director & Head, BIS Jammu & Kashmir Branch Office, highlighted the importance of maintaining continuous compliance with Indian Standards. He said BIS certification symbolizes quality, safety, reliability and consumer trust, and urged licensees to uphold the highest standards of quality to strengthen the quality culture in the country.

A detailed presentation on BIS activities and the standardization ecosystem was delivered by Saaqib Raahi, Scientist-C/Deputy Director, who explained the role of BIS in standardization, certification, testing, consumer affairs and quality promotion.

A technical session on guidelines for dealing with non-conformities and a live demonstration of the Manak Online portal (License Dashboard) was conducted by Vesalapu Avinash Babu, Scientist-D/Joint Director. Participants were apprised of compliance requirements, surveillance mechanisms and corrective actions for addressing non-conformities.

Another session on guidelines for renewal of licences was conducted by Manish Kumar, Scientist-D/Joint Director, focusing on fee struc-

ture, renewal procedures and best practices for maintaining compliance with BIS requirements.

The programme also provided an interactive platform for participants to engage with BIS officials, seek clarifications on certification-related matters and share their experiences and suggestions. Welcome kits were also distributed to the newly granted licensees.

The participants appreciated the initiative and said the programme significantly enhanced their understanding of BIS certification requirements, surveillance procedures and compliance obligations.

BIS JKBO reiterated its commitment to supporting industry stakeholders and promoting a culture of quality, standardization and consumer protection across the region.

DDC Reasi chairs DLPACC meeting, stresses community-centric development under PMAGY

District Development Commissioner Reasi Kumar Abhishek today chaired a meeting of the District Level Project Appraisal-cum-Convergence Committee to review the implementation of the Pradhan Mantri Anusuchit Jaati Abhyuday Yojana and approve Village Development Plans under the Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAGY).

A detailed presentation outlined the scheme's objectives, implementation framework, financial

progress and achievements in the district. It also reviewed ongoing developmental works, key socio-economic indicators and the convergence-based strategy adopted for the integrated development of Scheduled Caste-dominated villages.

The committee examined the Action Plans and Village Development Plans for three villages: Sersundwan (Block Bhomag), Sirah (Block Panthal) and Nelay (Block Panthal); prepared and recommended by the respective Village Level Convergence Committees. The committee was in-

formed that PMAGY focuses on improving the socio-economic conditions of Scheduled Caste communities through convergence of various government schemes, covering infrastructure development, livelihood generation, skill development, education, healthcare, sanitation and financial inclusion.

The DDC emphasised the need to bridge infrastructure gaps in the identified villages and directed departments to prioritise community-centric works over individual beneficiary-oriented projects. He highlighted key interventions in-

cluding upgradation of schools, restoration of springs, installation of solar lights, construction of community halls and playgrounds, establishment of model Anganwadi Centres and construction of dug wells.

He further directed departments to organise awareness and outreach programmes on financial inclusion and welfare schemes, ensuring saturation of eligible beneficiaries through opening of bank accounts and issuance of Aadhaar and Ayushman Bharat health cards. The Agriculture Depart-

ment was instructed to register eligible farmers under relevant schemes and promote participation in Kisan Khidmat Ghars. The DDC also stressed the need for skill development initiatives to enhance local employment opportunities and achieve 100 percent saturation of all welfare schemes in PMAGY villages.

Among those present were Additional District Development Commissioner Krishan Lal, Project Officer POSHAN, Chief Planning Officer, Chief Education Officer, Executive Engineers of Jal Shakti, JPDC and other officers concerned.
