Tech can lead to progress only if democratised: Modi

Says AI means 'All Inclusive' for India

PARIS, JUN 18: Prime Minister Narendra Modi today made a strong pitch for democratisation of technology, asserting that AI means "all inclusive" for India, days after the US imposed curbs on access to certain artificial intelligence models.

He also highlighted India's digital achievements, startup ecosystem and investment opportunities while calling for technology access that benefits everyone



His remarks at a global technology summit come against the backdrop of the US restricting the use of Anthropic's latest Artificial Intelligence (AI) models for foreign nationals.

Highlighting India's growing prowess in the technology space, Modi said half of the global digital transactions were happening in the country.

US, Iran sign initial deal to end war

Ease sanctions, open Strait

WASHINGTON, JUN 18: President Donald Trump signed an agreement with Iran that calls for Tehran to dilute its stockpile of highly enriched uranium and waives US-backed sanctions on the country, immediately allowing Iran to sell its oil freely in a major concession from Washington, according to details released by both countries.

The initial deal to end the war takes "immediate effect" after leaders from both countries signed it, Pakistani Prime Minister

Shehbaz Sharif, who helped mediate the agreement, said in a post on X.

The agreement calls for a permanent end to hostilities and starts a 60-day negotiating clock to reach a final deal on the future of Iran's nuclear programme, though Trump left the door open to resume attacks.

It appears to offer Iran several benefits up front while extracting little in return.

The deal has been shrouded in secrecy and confusion for days.

US officials refused to

disclose the terms even after saying Trump and Vice President JD Vance digitally signed it over the weekend.

Trump signed a physical copy on Wednesday while dining with French President Emmanuel Macron at Versailles, the palace where many historic agreements have been signed over the centuries, ending wars or territorial disputes.

The White House had planned a signing ceremony on Friday in Switzer
