

BIS conducts SHINE awareness program for women SHGs at Bhalwal

The Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), Jammu & Kashmir Branch Office, on Tuesday organized a SHINE (Standards Help Inform & Nurture Empowered Women) awareness programme for women Self-Help Groups at Bhalwal Block, Jammu.

The programme, held in coordination with the Jammu & Kashmir Rural Livelihoods Mission (JKRLM), witnessed enthusiastic participation from 28 women members of SHGs Jai Bua Pollu and Jai Bua Datti. The initiative aimed at promoting consumer awareness, quality standards and safe purchasing practices among women.

During the session, Rajeev Pandita, ToT Resource Person from BIS JKBO, delivered an interactive presentation on BIS standards and quality certification schemes. He highlighted the importance of BIS quality assurance marks such as the ISI mark, Hallmark Unique Identification (HUID) for gold jewellery, and BIS registration numbers for electronic and electrical products.

Through audio-visual presentations, live demon-



strations and certified product samples, participants were educated on identifying genuine quality-certified products. The BIS Care App was also showcased, enabling participants to understand how to verify product certifications, register complaints and access details related to BIS-certified products.

The programme covered several key areas concerning women and families, including infant care products, toy safety, hygiene and personal care products,

kitchen safety, healthcare products and contraceptive devices.

Participants were sensitized about quality and safety standards applicable to these products and the need to choose certified products to ensure safety and consumer protection.

Special emphasis was laid on consumer awareness regarding feeding bottles, infant nutrition products, diapers, sanitary pads, toys and contraceptives.

BIS-certified sanitary pads bearing the ISI mark

were distributed among SHG members during the programme.

The participants appreciated BIS for taking consumer awareness initiatives to grassroots communities and expressed keen interest in spreading the knowledge among their families and local communities.

The programme concluded with BIS reaffirming its commitment to empowering women through awareness of standards, quality, safety and informed consumer practices.
