

Shamita Shetty Shuts Down Troll Commenting On Her Marriage: 'Aapne Shaadi Karke Kya Ukhaad Liya?'



Actress Shamita Shetty on Wednesday took to her Instagram Story to give a befitting reply to a troll passing comments about her age, decision not to get married, and much more. The actress took to her Instagram and shared a screenshot of a man named Pankaj Mittal's profile while replying to his comments.

Shamita Shetty, on her Instagram Story, wrote, "I want to take this wonderful opportunity to respond to your wonderful comments: 'Apki age ho gayi hai pehle wali baat nahi rahi': Yes, I will look different. Things change with time; it's the natural way of life. Nothing stays forever, including physical appearance! BUT for my age, I'm healthy, fit, and happy with a grateful heart for all that the almighty has given me... n that's all that matters to me (sic)."

Replying to another comment by the man, Shamita added, "Agar shaadi time par kar leti to aapke bache aaj bade ho gaye hote": Toh? Yes, you stated the obvious... so? Aapne shaadi karke kya ukhaad liya hai bhai? Most importantly, why the hell do you follow us single women to age-shame us and inflict us with your patriarchal, cave-man-like, male-centric thought process! The younger sister of Shilpa Shetty, Shamita made her Bollywood debut with the 2000 romantic drama Mohabbatein. She later appeared in films such as Bewafaa, Zeher, and Cash.

After stepping away from mainstream cinema, Shamita found renewed fame through reality shows like Jhalak Dikhhla Jaa, Fear Factor: Khatron Ke

Khiladi, and Bigg Boss, where she reconnected with audiences and built a loyal fan following.

Shahana Says She's Not Casual In Open Relationships: 'Sometimes It's Friendship, Sometimes Physical'



Shahana Goswami has revealed that she is currently in an open relationship and does not have one "primary partner" in her life. The actor spoke candidly about love, intimacy and long-term emotional connections during a recent podcast conversation with Siddharth Kannan.

Known for films like Heroine, Zwigato and Santosh, Shahana Goswami said she has gradually built a different understanding of relationships over the years. During the podcast, the actor explained that openness, for her, is rooted in honesty and communication rather than secrecy.

Talking about her idea of an open relationship, she said, "It means open and honest communication with whoever you are with, being able to truly understand what kind of person your partner is and working on yourself. At this point, I don't even have one primary partner like that. I have many people with whom I have long-standing dynamics, but it's not casual. None of it is casual for me."

Shahana also explained that she does not see emotional bonding in rigid categories and believes relationships can take different forms over time.

'Love and friendship' are most important to her

The actor described open relationships as similar to friendships, where different people can share different emotional dynamics without fitting into one fixed label. She said, "So for me, at this point, openness means there's no clear-cut partnership with anyone, but there is this feeling of long-term bonding and connection that stays with you, no matter what form it takes. Sometimes it's just friendship. Sometimes it might be physical too. There's no need to force it into some specific direction. The baseline is simple: love and friendship. I have so much love to give, then why should I give to just one person?"

Shahana also added that transparency remains important in all her relationships and that nothing is hidden from the people involved in her life. According to the actor, her partners are aware that she may also bond emotionally or physically with other people.

Bhumi Pednekar Reacts To Viral Obscene Video, Demands Stricter Laws: 'We Are In A Pandemic'

Actor Bhumi Pednekar has reacted strongly to a viral video showing some men allegedly making obscene gestures towards a woman's wall painting near a swimming pool. The actor shared the clip on social media and demanded stricter laws against crimes targeting women and children.

The video, originally shared by the Instagram account Tube Indian, sparked outrage online. Bhumi reposted it on her Instagram Stories and spoke about what she described as a disturbing mindset among young people.

Bhumi Pednekar Calls Out 'Disturbing Mentality' Sharing the viral clip, Bhumi wrote, "This is the mentality of our youth. These are the same people who are going to sexually assault children and women. We are in a pandemic. Just words and showing shame isn't enough. Stricter laws, stricter laws, stricter laws."

Her reaction comes at a time when several incidents involving women's safety have triggered nationwide conversations. In recent days, reports related to alleged dowry harassment and mental torture cases have shocked people across the country.

One such case that recently drew attention involved the alleged dowry death of a 33-year-old woman in Bhopal.

Bhumi Earlier Reacted To Delhi Assault Case

This is not the first time Bhumi has publicly expressed anger over crimes against women and children. In January, the actor had reacted to reports about a six-year-old girl allegedly gang-raped by three boys aged 10, 13 and 14 in Delhi. Bhumi had then spoken about the environment children are growing up in and questioned society's response to such incidents.

The actor said, "Breaks my heart to see under age boys go through with something so heinous. Imagine the environments they are growing up in. We are punishing the voiceless in our country, and have sensationalised, dogs being a threat."

Debate Around Women's Safety Continues

Actors Kangana Ranaut and Ridhi Dogra have also recently



spoken about women valuing their independence and raising concerns around marriage-related pressures.

On the work front, Bhumi was last seen in Prime Video's series Daldal. Directed by Amrit Raj Gupta, the show is based on Vish Dhamija's bestselling book Bheni Bazaar. In the series, Bhumi played DCP Rita Ferreria, a police officer investigating a serial killer who slits the wrists of victims.

Before working with Alia in Alpha, Bobby Deol played the an-



tagonist in Ranbir Kapoor starrer Animal. "I'm very fond of Ranbir and Alia, and I always wanted to work with both of them. With Ranbir, I did Animal, and now with Alia, I have done Alpha. I had the best time working with both of them," the actor said.

Alia Bhatt and Bobby Deol's Alpha will be released on July 10. It will mark the first female-led film in YRF's spy-verse. Meanwhile, Bobby Deol will also be seen in Anurag Kashyap's Bandar, and Alia Bhatt is shooting for Sanjay Leela Bhansali's Love and War.
