Believing that this versatility makes her well-suited for Indian cinema, Millie also opened

up about the possibility of taking on a Bollywood project in the future.

During her interaction with *Variety India*, Millie Bobby Brown expressed her wish to feature in a Bollywood film. She also said that she would love to feature in a comedy film since she is a funny person. She said, "Absolutely. I'll never say no. India is on my bucket list. I really, really want to go. She added, "In '*Enola Holmes 1*' and '*Enola Holmes 2*', I did a lot of action scenes. There was a lot of physicality in my fighting. However, it took a lot for me to agree to holding a gun because there was so much about *Enola's* weaponry that was in her body and her strength. But yes, this time around, she does have tools and accessories in her armour. It was really fun."

The *Enola Holmes* franchise began in 2020 with the release of the first film, which introduced Millie as the spirited teenage detective *Enola Holmes*, the younger sister of the legendary *Sherlock Holmes*, portrayed by Henry Cavill. Directed by Harry Bradbeer and written by Jack Thorne, the film was adapted from the first novel in Nancy Springer's *The Enola Holmes Mysteries* series. Its sequel arrived in 2022, and the third instalment is now set to premiere on Netflix on July 1.

Actress Priyanka Chopra has made it clear that she does not believe household chores should be tied to gender. Speaking at Cannes Lions, the global star pushed back against the long-held belief that cooking and cleaning are responsibilities meant primarily for women.

During the conversation, Priyanka stressed that everyday household tasks are basic life skills that every adult should learn, regardless of whether they are a man or a woman. "Cleaning and cooking aren't women's work. They're basic adulting. Don't confuse gender with laziness."

Her comments came as she reflected on changing social attitudes and the need to move beyond outdated stereotypes surrounding domestic re-

sponsibilities. Priyanka argued that assigning chores based on gender misses the point, adding that such skills are simply part of everyday adult life.

The actress also spoke about how technology has reshaped opportunities in the entertainment industry. According to her, entering the world of filmmaking was once a far more difficult process, with aspiring creators often needing to find a specific department or pathway just to get a foot in the door. "If you wanted to get into filmmaking, you used to have to figure out what department you wanted to be in. It was really hard to get into the industry," Priyanka said.

She pointed out that digital platforms have dramatically changed that reality, giving creators a direct route to audiences and allowing ideas to find success without relying entirely on traditional industry systems.

Now, if you "feel like you have an idea, shoot it, put it on YouTube, and it can become *Obsession*, the movie that just came out right now. What a wonderful time to be an entertainer, to be in the entertainment business," she added.

Away from the discussion on gender roles and filmmaking, Priyanka is gearing up for a busy period professionally. The actress recently confirmed that she will be collaborating with Angelina Jolie on a new project, although she chose not to reveal any details about its nature.

Speaking to *Fortune India*, Priyanka confirmed the collaboration but did not clarify whether it is a film, commercial venture or philanthropic initiative. The announcement has already sparked curiosity among fans eager to see the two international stars work together.

She is also set to launch another venture with Orlando Bloom, adding to a growing list of projects currently on her slate.

Meanwhile, closer home, Priyanka is gearing up for *SS Rajamouli's* upcoming film *Varanasi*, in which she stars opposite Telugu superstar Mahesh Babu and Prithviraj Sukumaran.
