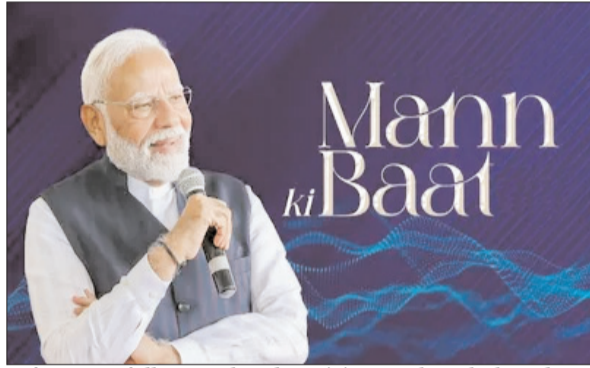
After 15-yr-wait, 263 CRPF officers get first promotion

From seas to skies, India becoming increasingly self-reliant: Modi

NEW DELHI, JUN 28: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday highlighted several milestones achieved by the country to become self-reliant as he cited the maiden flight of the made-in-India C-295 aircraft and the successful test of the indigenous Long-Range Land-Attack Cruise Missile.



In his monthly radio broadcast 'Mann Ki Baat', he noted that in June itself, the country had achieved a major success in the aviation sector.

The IAF is procuring 56 C-295 transport aircraft at a cost of around Rs 21,935 crore. Forty of these aircraft will be assembled by Tata Advanced Systems Limited in cooperation with Airbus at a production facility in Vadodra.
