# CPCO Amit Sharma reviews Census HLO progress in South Kashmir

Chief Principal Census Officer (CPCO)/Director Census Operations, Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, Amit Sharma conducted random visits to South Kashmir areas, including Dooru-Verinag and Koker-nag, to assess the progress of the ongoing Householding and Housing Census (Phase-I) under Census 2027.

During the visit, Amit Sharma inspected house numbering, mapping and enumeration processes in various locations to ensure adherence to census guidelines and notifications issued from time to time. He interacted with enumerators and supervisors to obtain firsthand feedback on field-level implementation, challenges and overall progress of the exercise.



The CPCO emphasized the importance of accuracy, completeness and timely

completion of the census process, while urging field staff to maintain dedication

and prepare effectively for Phase-II of Population Enumeration.

Highlighting the significance of Census as a crucial national exercise, Amit Sharma said reliable census data forms the foundation for evidence-based governance, developmental planning and equitable resource distribution.

He also reiterated that data collected during Census 2027 remains strictly confidential under Section 15 of the Census Act, 1948, and cannot be shared with any external agency or individual.

He directed charge officers and supervisors to ensure regular inspections and quality checks, stressing comprehensive coverage of all households, including those in remote, border and seasonal settlements, to maintain the highest standards of data integrity.
