National Children's Science Congress Registration Opens in J&K; Students Aged 10-17 Invited to Participate

The registration process for the National Children's Science Congress (NCSC)-2026 has commenced in Jammu and Kashmir, inviting students between the ages of 10 and 17 years to participate in one of the country's premier science outreach programmes. A flagship initiative of the National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NC-STC), Department of Science and Technology, Government of India, the NCSC aims to promote scientific thinking and innovation among school students through hands-on research and problem-

solving. The focal theme for the 2026 edition is "Science and Innovation for Sustainability." Under this theme, participants will undertake micro-level research projects addressing local issues while applying the scientific method and learning through practical experience. Officials said the programme provides a unique platform for young scientists and innovators to experiment, innovate and translate ideas into practical solutions for sustainable development. Online registration for the programme has been opened through the official NCSC portal. Stu-

dents from across Jammu and Kashmir are encouraged to register and submit their project proposals within the prescribed timeline. The organisers said detailed information regarding sub-themes, eligibility criteria and participation guidelines is available on the official website of the J&K Students Welfare Society, the state organising agency for the programme. Students, teachers and educational institutions have been urged to make the most of the opportunity to foster scientific temperament and encourage innovation among young learners across the Union Territory.

CWC asks cyber police to remove viral video of minor student

**RAMBAN, July 7:** The Child Welfare Committee (CWC), Ramban, has directed the Cyber Police Station, Ramban, to immediately identify and remove all social media posts, URLs and digital platforms circulating a viral video of a minor student involved in the recent Government Middle School Krawah incident in Banihal, citing violations of child protection laws.

In an order issued on Tuesday by Chairperson CWC Ramban Nighat Ghani said the incident relates to a Class 7 student of Government Middle School Krawah, Banihal, who was accidentally locked inside the school after reportedly falling asleep in a classroom on the last working day before the 15-day summer vacation. The child was later rescued by a local passerby.

According to the order, the continued circulation of the videos could expose the child to public scrutiny, online harassment, identity misuse and long-term psychological harm.

The CWC has directed the Cyber Police to immediately identify the social media accounts, URLs and digital platforms hosting or sharing the videos and initiate legal measures to ensure their removal or blocking through the concerned intermediaries.

The Cyber Police has also been asked to initiate legal action against individuals involved in recording, publishing, interviewing or broadcasting content featuring the minor in contravention of child protection laws.

The Child Welfare Committee has directed the Cyber Police to submit an action taken report within three days of receiving the order.

The directive comes days after the Chief Education Officer, Ramban, suspended the entire staff of Government Middle School Krawah and ordered a departmental inquiry into the incident in which the student was found locked inside the school premises for several hours.

Applications invited for establishment of ATVM Facilitators, STBA and YTSA in Jammu

**JAMMU, JULY 07:** With the objective of providing better and convenient ticketing facilities to passengers and employment opportunities to unemployed youth, Northern Railway, Jammu Division has invited applications from eligible individuals and agencies for setting up \*Automatic Ticket Vending Machine (ATVM) Facilitators\*, \*Station Ticket Booking Agents (STBA) outside station premises\*, and \*Yatri Ticket Suvidha Kendras (YTSA)\* at various stations of the division.

The last date for submitting applications is \*29 July 2026 for ATVM Facilitators\*, \*22 July 2026 for STBA\* and \*23 July 2026 for YTSA\*.

The \*Automatic Ticket Vending Machine\* is a touch-screen based machine installed by Railways at stations. Its main objective is to provide relief to passengers from long queues for purchasing unreserved tickets, platform tickets and monthly season tickets. ATVM Facilitators are also deployed at stations to assist passengers who are unable to operate the machine.

Under the \*Station Ticket Booking Agent\* scheme, private agents will be appointed at small railway stations to provide unreserved tickets to the general public. The main objective is to provide tickets to passengers easily without any hassle and to reduce the workload at railway ticket counters. This facility will mainly be applicable at \*NSG-4, 5 and NSG-6 category stations\*. Agents will be provided commission at a prescribed percentage by Railways on ticket sales.

The \*Yatri Ticket Suvidha Kendra\* is a PPP - Public Private Partnership scheme of Railways.

Under this, permission will be granted to open railway ticket counters in markets. At these centres, passengers can book both reserved and unreserved tickets. As per Railway rules, these centres will be allowed to charge an additional service fee from passengers. Priority will be given to experienced agents under this scheme.

After the formation of the new Jammu Division, providing fast and transparent services to passengers at the local level is a priority for Railways. Through the Automatic Ticket Vending Machine, Station Ticket Booking Agent and Yatri Ticket Suvidha Kendra, ticketing operations will be conducted more smoothly and the problem of staff shortage will also be addressed, as the ticketing load will be distributed among these agencies and machines.

This initiative, under the leadership of \*Senior Divisional Commercial Manager, Jammu, Shri Uchit Singhal\*, is an important step by Jammu Division towards promoting \*Digital India\*. It will encourage cashless transactions and technology-based ticketing. Along with this, these schemes will also create new direct and indirect self-employment opportunities for local youth, self-help groups and experienced agents.

Regarding this, \*Senior Divisional Commercial Manager, Jammu, Shri Uchit Singhal\* said, The new Jammu Division is fully committed to both passenger service and development.

ATVM, STBA and YTSA are not just ticket selling centres, but they are a bridge of trust between the public and Railways. Our commitment is that every passenger of Jammu Division, whether in urban areas or in remote villages, gets maximum facilities in minimum time.

Through these schemes we want to make ticketing completely digital and transparent, so that passengers get relief from long queues and receive respectable service near their homes.

Along with this, our objective is also to make local youth self-reliant. I am fully confident that this initiative will establish Jammu Division as a model division for Northern Railway in the field of passenger amenities."

- Women candidate in the age group of 18-37 years as of 01-01-2026 shall be considered for the post.
- Candidate should be a domicile of UT of J&K.
- The candidate should be a resident of the electoral ward where AWC is situated. Name in the voter list for the ward shall be considered as the proof of residence of the candidate. In case the name of the candidate appears in voter list along with her parent's then she must provide certificate of being unmarried issued by the concerned Tehsildar. Wherever, there is any dispute as to residence for any reason, and then a resident proof certifying the ward of residence from the concerned SDM/ACR shall be considered.
- Minimum qualification for Anganwadi worker shall be 10+2 and maximum graduation. In case no 10+2 pass candidate is available in the ward, 10+2 pass candidate from the adjoining ward shall be considered which would require prior approval of Mission Director, Mission Poshan.
- In case suitable candidate is not available from adjoining ward, candidate from the nearest ward within the Panchayat can be considered subject to the approval of the Mission Director, Mission Poshan.
- Weightage shall be given on the basis of marks obtained in 10+2 and selection shall be done purely on merit basis and no other criteria to be considered.
- In case eligible candidate is available within the family of retiring AWW/AWH the said candidates shall qualify for additional two percent points.
- In case of tie in merit of the eligible candidate, candidate with higher age will be preferred.
- Candidates with qualification higher than graduation shall not be considered.
