Adarsh Baal Vidyalaya Trailer: Kay Kay Menon Takes Charge Of A Chaotic Delhi School

Prime Video has unveiled the trailer of its upcoming original series Adarsh Baal Vidyalaya, a seven-episode comedy-drama led by Kay Kay Menon. Set inside a chaotic government school in Delhi, the series follows a headmaster who suddenly discovers that improving board results may be his ticket to a prestigious training programme in Cambridge.

Directed by Himank Gaur, the show has been created and executive produced by Biswapati Sarkar and Sameer Saxena under Posham Pa Pictures. It will begin streaming on July 24 in Hindi with English subtitles.

Kay Kay Menon Steps Into A Lighter Role

At the centre of the series is Gyaneshwar Tripathi, played by Kay Kay Menon. He is not the stern, idealistic principal one might expect from a school drama. Instead, Gyaneshwar appears relaxed, resourceful and perfectly accustomed to surviving dysfunction.

His priorities shift after he learns that the headmasters of Delhi's ten best-performing schools will be sent to Cambridge for a government-sponsored training programme. What follows is his attempt to push Adarsh Baal Vidyalaya up the academic rankings, despite uncooperative circumstances, unpredictable staff members and students who rarely make things easy.

The trailer draws much of its humour from the gap between Gyaneshwar's ambition and the school's unruly reality. Rules bend,



problems multiply and every improvement seems to trigger another complication.

A Crowded School Full Of Distinct Personalities

The series also features Archana Puran Singh as Urmila Devi, a loud, ambitious and unapologetic presence who appears to share an enterprisingly combative equation with Gyaneshwar.

The ensemble includes Abhimanyu Singh, Naveen Kasturia, Prasanna Bisht, Deven Bhojani, Ajitesh Gupta, Annapurna Soni and Prachee Shah. Together, they populate a school where teachers, parents and students bring their own agendas into an already difficult system.

Rather than treating education only as a social issue, Adarsh Baal Vidyalaya appears to approach its setting through humour. The trailer hints at limited resources and institutional disorder, but it also focuses

on the people trying, however imperfectly, to keep the school functioning.

Director Himank Gaur said the series grew out of memories associated with school life, including friendships, mischief, teachers and small incidents that remain vivid long after graduation.

Kay Kay Menon described Gyaneshwar as flawed yet sharp, adding that the role appealed to him because it was unlike the intelligence officers, politicians and criminals he has played in recent projects. Archana Puran Singh, meanwhile, credited the writing for giving Urmila humour, confidence and emotional authenticity.

TV Actor Rohit Chandel Arrested, Accused Of 'Stalking, Assaulting' 16-Year-Old Girl

Along with the POCSO Act, Rohit Chandel has also been booked under Sections 78 and 115(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), which deal with stalking and causing hurt.

Television actor Rohit Chandel, who is best known for his roles in Pandya Store and Kashibai Bajirao Ballal, has been arrested by the Mumbai Police. He has been accused of allegedly stalking, repeatedly calling, harassing and assaulting a 16-year-old girl. A case has been registered against the actor under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act.

Reportedly, the 29-year-old actor was arrested by the Pant Nagar Police from his Dahisar residence on Friday, July 10. He was later produced before a special POCSO court, which remanded him to police custody.

As per the FIR, the accused made repeated phone calls to the minor from his personal number as well as other mobile numbers despite her objections. The complaint also states that on July 5, the actor allegedly stopped the girl near her housing society, followed her, got into a verbal altercation, abused her and allegedly assaulted her.

Therefore, along with the POCSO Act, he has also been booked under Sections 78 and 115(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), which deal with stalking and voluntarily causing hurt.

While further investigation is currently underway, a police official said, "Following the complaint, a case was registered and the accused has been placed under arrest. Further probe is underway in the case," as quoted by The Times of India.

It should be noted that the actor or his team has not issued any public statement or reacted to the allegations or his arrest as of now.

Aadhe acting community ko insaaf chahiye bhi nahi, but unhe dilana hai. Wow. I think mujhe ek cheez ka regret hai ki maine us aadmi ko sunaya nahi. Mujhe bhi sunana chahiye tha unhe."

She also spoke about being known as Urfi's sister and whether she has managed to break free from that image. She said, "I think I have managed to break the image of only being Urfi's sister, but I have to say this: I love this tag. She has made this name for herself, and I would love to be known as her sister. I wouldn't have been here without her, and I wouldn't have been on the show without her. So, I love to be known as Urfi's sister."



On a concluding note, Dolly shared her interest in entering the show as a wild card and revealed what she would want to do differently. "I would love to enter the show as a wild card. I only have one regret, that I didn't say sorry to Kushal. Sorry isliye kyunki mujhe tumhe aur gaali deni chahiye thi, tumse aur badtameezi karni chahiye thi, tumhari toh aur beizzati karni chahiye thi," Dolly concluded.
