

BIS-JKBO holds consumer awareness programme for RWA members at Jagti

Over 50 members of the Kashmiri Pandit Coordination Committee (KPCC), Jagti, participated in the programme held under the guidance of KPCC General Secretary Chaman Lal Pandita.

Addressing the participants, BIS Standard Promotion Officer Ashish Dwivedi highlighted various consumer-centric initiatives of BIS, including standardisation, product certification, hallmarking of gold jewellery and quality assurance. He stressed the importance of purchasing BIS-certified products and reporting substandard products available in the market.

Dwivedi explained the significance of the ISI Mark and BIS Hallmark, besides creating awareness about Quality Control Orders (QCOs) issued by the



Government of India, which mandate BIS certification for several products to ensure consumer safety and environmental protection.

A live demonstration of the BIS Care App was also conducted, enabling participants to learn how to verify ISI-marked products, check the authenticity of hallmarked gold jewellery, lodge complaints against substandard products and access details of BIS-certified manufacturers.

The programme concluded with an interactive question-and-answer session, during which participants raised queries related to product certification, hallmarking, QCOs and consumer safety. The session ended with a vote of thanks, reaffirming BIS-JKBO's commitment to promoting consumer awareness and encouraging informed purchasing decisions.

Ashok Koul calls for stronger digital outreach, grassroots coordination

MLA Inspects Akhnoor Grid Station, Directs Immediate Measures to Improve Power Supply

In view of the persistent and unscheduled power outages causing inconvenience to residents, Akhnoor MLA Mohan Lal on Friday visited the Akhnoor Grid Station to review the prevailing power supply scenario and assess the technical issues affecting electricity distribution.

During the inspection, officials informed the MLA that electricity supply to Akhnoor town is currently distributed through City-1 and City-2 feeders.

While the City-1 feeder is carrying nearly 450 amperes of load, the City-2 feeder is carrying only around 175 amperes, re-



sulting in an uneven distribution of load and frequent tripping in the City-1 area.

Taking serious note of the imbalance, the MLA directed the concerned officials to immediately ratio-

nalize the load between the two feeders to ensure equitable distribution and provide uninterrupted power supply to consumers across the town.

The review further revealed that the additional

load of the Kalakote line on the Akhnoor Grid Station is also contributing to repeated power interruptions. Expressing concern over the issue, the MLA instructed Chief Engineer (Transmission), Habib Chaudhary, to convene a high-level meeting at the earliest with all concerned officers to examine the matter in detail and formulate a permanent technical solution.

Mohan Lal emphasized that reliable electricity is an essential public service and directed the Power Development Department to address all technical bottlenecks on priority to minimize disruptions and improve the quality of power supply for the people of Akhnoor.

The inspection was attended by Engineer Narinder Sharma, Engineer Vishal Uttam, along with other officials and staff of the Power Development Department.
