

Huma Qureshi Says CJP's 'Chalo Sansad' March Visuals Left Her With A 'Deep Sense Of Sadness'



Today, about 50,000 protesters came out on Delhi's streets to join the 'Chalo Sansad' march from Jantar Mantar to Parliament. Now, as visuals from the capital city surfaced online, Huma Qureshi reacted to the alleged lathi-charge by the police on the students and the protesters. The actress, while taking to her Instagram, dropped a long note and shared that she was left with "a deep sense of sadness."

Taking to her Instagram, Huma Qureshi wrote, "The visuals from today will stay with me for a very long time. Seeing peaceful protestors being met with such brute force and lathis left me with a deep sense of sadness. This surely could have been handled with much more patience, more listening and more dia-

logue."

She added, "We, the people of India, elected this government and today we all need to ask questions and expect accountability. We are a huge, diverse nation. We don't all have to agree on every issue, but surely we can agree that every citizen deserves to be heard with dignity before force becomes the response."

"Respect to every student and every citizen who chose to stand peacefully for what they believe in. Jai Hind," Huma concluded.

Hema Malini and Kangana Ranaut react to CJP protest

Speaking to the media, Hema Malini and Kangana Ranaut, who attended the first day of the Monsoon Session, criticised the protest.

Hema said, "If there is a problem, it should be discussed properly. Protesting in this manner won't achieve anything. As for the country's youth and the education system, our Modi government has always stood by them and done a great deal of work. Given that, the protests you are staging now make no sense at all."

Kangana said, "If you feel so strongly, you should stand for election yourself. You cannot arm-twist the government into deciding who to sack and who to retain; this kind of arm-twisting is not acceptable. Gradually, everyone will seek refuge in the Bharatiya Janata Party and the Sanatan culture because this is our own culture, whereas everything else has been borrowed from the rest of the world."

After 4 Years In Limbo, Mrunal Thakur-Huma Qureshi's Pooja Meri Jaan Finally Gets A Release



Pooja Meri Jaan is finally seeing the light of day after being in a limbo for four long years. The thriller, which has been delayed for so long, will now be released on Zee 5. Recently, the streaming platform announced the film's premiere as part of its upcoming slate. As of now, the exact release date remains unclear.

Pooja Meri Jaan is directed by Navjot Gulati and backed by Dinesh Vijan's Maddock Films. The film faced uncertainties because it was initially scheduled for release on JioCinema. However, after its merger with Disney+ Hotstar, the film hit a roadblock.

Starring Mrunal Thakur and Huma Qureshi, Pooja Meri Jaan completed shooting in August 2022.

Since then, no update was given to them about the release. In February this year, director Navjot Gulati had publicly expressed his anguish, urging Dinesh Vijan's Maddock Films to finally release the long-stalled project. Gulati revealed that the film was originally commissioned for OTT and slated to premiere on JioCinema. However, after JioCinema's merger with Disney+ Hotstar, producers were allegedly informed that the film could be sold elsewhere. That, Gulati claimed, is where the delays began.

In a heartfelt conversation with Variety India, Gulati revealed that his father, who passed away in 2024, kept asking about the film's release during the final months of his life. He shared that his father never stopped hoping the film would be released and kept asking when Pooja Meri Jaan would finally reach audiences. Gulati said it was his father's final wish—one that is yet to come true.

He claimed that co-producer Amar Kaushik has not responded to his calls or messages since October 2025. "I'm tired of calling and texting and yet not hearing back," he said. "The only reason I'm speaking publicly is because there's no accountability. The film is still topical and relevant. But if I don't push now, I fear it may never be released because they simply don't care."

The thriller film, Pooja Meri Jaan, shows the intense world of stalking and cybercrime.
