CJP Protests: Preity Zinta Urges Govt To Start Dialogue, Says 'Students Fighting For Future Of India'



Amid the protests in the national capital by the Cockroach Janta Party, Preity Zinta has urged the central government to start a dialogue. On Tuesday, the Bollywood actress took to her X handle and expressed concern for Sonam Wangchuk's health. She requested him to end his hunger strike and extended her support to protesting students.

"I hope our govt starts a meaningful dialogue with Sonam Wangchuk and the student bodies so his health does not deteriorate any further! Please end your fast Sonam. Your health is as important as this fight. You and the students are fighting for the future of India and for our youth. My heartfelt & unwavering support to every student & to Sonam in this fight to uplift & upgrade our educational system. More power to all of you. Jai Hind," Preity wrote.

Several actors, including Shabana Azmi, Sonu Sood, Prakash Raj and Riteish Deshmukh have also come out, expressing their support for the CJP. Earlier today, Sonu Sood publicly backed the CJP-led student protests, urging authorities to treat students with empathy rather than force. The actor said young people deserve to be heard and called for a fair resolution to concerns surrounding alleged NEET irregularities.

Veteran actress Shabana Azmi visited Jantar Mantar ahead of the CJP's Chalo Sansad march and addressed the gathering. She stressed that peaceful protest is a constitutional right and urged authorities to listen to the concerns of students.

Meanwhile, in a long note on his social media, Diljit Dosanjh also condemned the violence witnessed during the protests and called on authorities to engage with the students' demands. He said students should not be mistreated and appealed for a peaceful and constructive resolution.

The Instagram fan page is named 'katholic_fans' and has over 70,000 followers.

I have been your fan since childhood, but you can't say a word for us Indians and students who love you from the bottom of our hearts.

You don't have the spine to speak against the government. You betrayed us when we supported you at your lowest. I am unfollowing you and closing this fan page. You don't deserve it," the fan page wrote in a statement.

Soon after the post was shared, several social media users reacted to it and praised the decision. "Respect for the admin," one of the users wrote. "I am glad you're closing fan page," added another.

Katrina's Fans Defend Her

However, some of Katrina Kaif's fans also defended her, saying she can choose what to support or not. "If you live in a democracy, so does she. If you can choose what you want to support, so can she. And if you can't support her for what she chooses to support—even if you completely disagree—you were never a true fan. Also, stop blackmailing people over who they support. She's an adult, and she knows what's right and what's wrong," one of the



fans wrote.
