

Malaika Arora Slams Khesari Lal Yadav, Condemns ‘Disgusting’ Treatment Of Stray Dog



Actress and fitness enthusiast Malaika Arora has expressed her utter disappointment over a viral video featuring Bhojpuri superstar Khesari Lal Yadav, where a stray dog was allegedly mishandled in presence of the Bhojpuri actor. Taking to her social media account, Malaika reshared the video and wrote, “Wtffffr these people ya ??? N who is this guy

The actress has even been seen allowing them to sit inside her vehicle while showering them with affection. Meanwhile, Khesari Lal Yadav, as of yet has not issued any statement addressing the incident or reacted to it.

standing n posing ??? DISGUSTING (sic).”
The viral clip shows Khesari Lal Yadav posing for the paparazzi in front of an event standee while a stray dog is seen peacefully lying on the green carpet near his feet. Initially, the actor appears to gesture in an attempt to shoo the dog away subtly so that the photo session can continue. Bur, when the canine refuses to move, an assistant is seen approaching and nudges the dog with his leg before dragging it away from the spot.
The dog, unaware of the situation and intentions of the human, appears to mistake the assistant’s gesture for affection and rolls over, asking for belly rubs.
While Malaika’s Story did not directly name or accuse Khesari Lal Yadav of harming the animal, she made it clear that she found the overall incident disturbing and unacceptable.

Malaika, for the uninitiated is known for her deep love for animals and has often been spotted interacting with stray dogs during her daily outings. A lot many videos of the actress outside her gym have gone viral over the period of time showing her petting, feeding and playing with the indie dogs stationed near the premises.

The strays are so familiar with her that they often run towards her car when she leaves the gym.

'Kaun Sa Youth Hai Yeh?': Priyanka Chopra's Cousin Meera Chopra Slams CJP Protester For Abusing PM Modi



Actress Meera Chopra has expressed her disappointment over a CJP protester allegedly using abusive language against Prime Minister Narendra Modi. On Thursday, Priyanka Chopra’s cousin took to X (formerly Twitter) and reshared a video showing a female protester allegedly using abusive language on a microphone. The user who originally shared the video claimed that the protester was a NEET rank holder.
Sharing this video, Meera questioned the behavior and wrote, “Is this the youth of today? Ya neet ki student? Plz batao kaun sa youth hai ye???”
Meera Chopra had earlier extended her support to the students amid the ongoing protest. She



urged authorities to listen to their concerns, calling them the future of the country. However, she also cautioned against political parties using students’ issues for their own agendas, saying that a child’s future should not become a political weapon.
“Listen to the students. They are not just protesters — they are the future of this country. Their genuine concerns must be heard, understood, and addressed. But we must also recognize those trying to use their shoulders to fire their political guns. Whether it is #CJP or #AAP, no political party should be allowed to hijack the students’ struggle for its own agenda. A child’s future is not a political weapon. Let the students be heard—but don’t let politi-

cians or wannabe politicians use them,” she had written.
Several Bollywood celebrities have voiced their opinions amid the ongoing CJP protest. Many stars like Salman Khan, Alia Bhatt, Naseeruddin Shah, Sonakshi Sinha, and Diljit Dosanjh, among others, have expressed support for students and urged that their concerns be heard through peaceful dialogue.
The protest at Jantar Mantar began earlier this month, with students highlighting concerns over alleged discrepancies in competitive examinations, including the NEET paper leak issue. They called for reforms in the education system and sought the resignation of Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan.

News18 Showsha gave this movie a 3-star rating. “Jana Nayagan may have moments of grandeur but the visual scale cannot compensate for weak writing. A political drama requires powerful ideas, strong characters and engaging conflicts. This one has a message in bold but it does not have the cinematic strength to deliver that message effectively. Yet, despite its shortcomings, the film succeeds where it perhaps matters most,” a part of our review reads.
Meanwhile, Trisha Krishnan also celebrated Vijay’s birthday recently. She took to her Instagram handle and dropped a photo from Tamil Nadu Chief Minister’s birthday celebration. In the

After director H Vinoth revealed that the actress has a limited screen time with Vijay in the upcoming political thriller, sources close to Pooja have now shared that she gave a nod to Jana Nayagan purely because it’s Vijay’s last, ambitious theatrical spectacle and she was keen on making it memorable.
“Pooja has several crucial scenes. It was incredibly sweet of her to onboard Jana Nayagan because it marks Thalapathy Vijay’s last film before he invests himself entirely into politics. She was keen and equally excited to make it memorable. Considering that Pooja and Vijay’s pairing has connected well with the audience through Beast, it was her respect and bond with Vijay that made her say yes to the film,” reveals a source close to the actress.
Besides Vijay and Pooja Hegde, Jana Nayagan also stars Bobby Deol and Mamitha Baiju among others.
While details about the film’s plot aren’t known, the official synopsis of the movie states, “An ordinary man becomes an unexpected figure of resistance when a local injustice pushes him into the public eye. As his actions inspire others, he faces increasing pressure from those threatened by his rise. The story tracks his evolution from bystander to reluctant leader as he navigates danger, ideals, and community expectations.”
Helmed by director H Vinoth, the film was initially scheduled to hit theatres on January 9, 2026. However, it was then postponed due to



certification issues. The film was referred to a Revising Committee following complaints alleging that certain scenes portrayed religious sentiments and the armed forces in an objectionable manner. The film was granted an ‘A – Adult Only’ certificate earlier this month. Directed by H Vinoth, Jana Nayagan will now hit theatres on July 23, 2026.
