

Special Lok-Adalat for Matrimonial cases held at Udhampur

UDHAMPUR, AUGUST 01: A Special Lok Adalat for Matrimonial Cases was held today across district Udhampur under the chairmanship of Kalpana Revo, Principal District & Sessions Judge/Chairperson, District Legal Services Authority (DLSA), Udhampur. The Special Lok Adalat

was organized with the objective of facilitating the amicable settlement of matrimonial disputes through mutual consent and conciliation, thereby reducing the burden of prolonged litigation and promoting speedy, cost-effective justice.

A total of Nine (09) benches, comprising Judicial Officers, Senior Advocates and Panel Lawyers were constituted across district Udhampur to hear and resolve cases through compromise and settlement. The benches made concerted efforts to encourage dialogue between the parties and achieve mutually acceptable resolutions.

During the proceedings, 54 matrimonial cases were taken up, out of which 09 cases were successfully settled.

In addition to the District Headquarters, similar Special Lok Adalats were also conducted at the Tehsil Legal Services Committees (TLSCs) of Ramnagar, Maljatta and Chenani, ensuring wider access to alternative dispute resolution mechanisms and extending the benefits of speedy and amicable justice to litigants across different parts of the district.

The successful conduct of the Special Lok Adalat reflects the continued commitment of the District Legal Services Authority Udhampur towards promoting peaceful dispute resolution, reducing pendency of cases and making justice more accessible to the public.

Ladakh Cooperatives Deptt holds Industry Interaction in Jammu to Boost linkages of Pashmina Market

The Cooperatives Department, Union Territory of Ladakh, in collaboration with the All Changthang Pashmina Growers Cooperative Society Ltd., on Saturday organised a one-day interaction-cum-seminar with members of the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), industrial representatives, textile entrepreneurs, traders and buyers in Jammu to strengthen market linkages for authentic Ladakh Pashmina and improve returns for Changpa pastoralists.

The seminar brought together key stakeholders from the textile and handicrafts sectors to explore opportunities for direct procurement of GI-tagged Ladakh Pashmina from the Cooperative Society. Deliberations focused on quality assurance, branding, value addition, market expansion and building long-term business partnerships.

Addressing the gathering, Deputy Commissioner, Changthang, Nitish Rajora, IAS, described the Pashmina sector as the economic backbone of the Changthang region. He said direct engagement between industry and producers would ensure transparent procurement, fair pricing and sustainable livelihoods for Changpa herders. He urged industrial stakeholders to establish long-term partnerships with the Cooperative Society and support the promotion of authentic Ladakh Pashmina in domestic and international markets.



Representatives of the All Changthang Pashmina Growers Cooperative Society highlighted the Society's initiatives to strengthen procurement systems, improve quality standards and

enhance the income of Pashmina-producing families across Changthang. Members of CII and participating industrial representatives appreciated the superior quality of Ladakh Pashmina and expressed strong interest in developing direct sourcing arrangements and collaborative business models with the Cooperative Society.

The programme concluded with an interactive session between buyers and producers, providing a platform to discuss market expectations, product quality and future avenues of cooperation.

Deputy Registrar, Cooperatives, Ladakh, proposed the vote of thanks and expressed appreciation to CII members, industrial representatives, buyers and all stakeholders for their active participation. He reaffirmed the commitment of the Cooperatives Department to strengthening market access for Ladakh Pashmina and ensuring that the benefits of value addition and improved market linkages reach the Changpa herders, the traditional custodians of this prized natural fibre.

Successful Operation of Special Trains for Convenience of Passengers Stranded in Kashmir due to NH Blockade

Due to heavy rainfall and inclement weather, the *Srinagar to Udhampur section of National Highway-44* was closed. Keeping in view the convenience of passengers stranded at Srinagar and Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Katra railway stations*, Jammu Division took immediate action and operated special trains today, *01 August 2026*, from *Budgam to Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Katra* and back to Budgam.

Talking about the train schedule, the special train from Budgam departed at *13:00 hrs* from Budgam and reached *Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Katra* at 16:20 hrs* with halts at Srinagar, Banihal, and Sangaldan stations. On the return journey, the train departed from *Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Katra* at 17:05 hrs* and reached Budgam at *20:30 hrs* via Sangaldan, Banihal, and Srinagar.

In addition, a *one-way special train* was also operated from *Banihal to Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Katra*. This train departed from Banihal at *16:30 hrs* and reached Katra at *18:30 hrs*.

These special trains provided assistance to approximately 2,200 passengers*



in reaching their destinations safely and on time. This initiative not only gave great relief to the stranded passengers but also helped in reducing crowds at stations, providing alternate transport facilities, and giving prompt assistance to passengers in an emergency situation. A large number of passengers appreciated and expressed gratitude for this prompt and passenger-friendly service by Railways.

Shri Uchit Singhal, Senior Divisional Commercial Manager, Jammu said, "The safety and convenience of passengers is our top priority. As soon as we received information about NH-44 being closed, Jammu Division immediately decided to operate special trains so that stranded passengers could get relief. Today, around 2,200 passengers availed these trains. I appreciate the promptness and dedication of our railway staff. Jammu Division remains committed to providing safe and convenient travel to passengers even in any emergency situation in the future."
