

## Shubhangi Atre Recalls 'Scary' Teen Stalking Incident: 'Peeche Aana, Bike Pe Chakkar Lagana'



Shubhangi Atre recalled being stalked by a man as a teenager in Indore, saying he followed her on a bike and wrote their names on roads, leaving her family terrified.

Television actress Shubhangi Atre has revealed a shocking teenage incident of being followed by a man. In a recent interview, Shubhangi opened up about a teenage incident where a man stalked her on his bike and even wrote their names together across roads.

Shubhangi Atre, while speaking to Hauterrfly's The Male Feminist, opened up about the horrifying

incident and shared, "That's a very scary event of my life. I was in 10th-11th, studying in Indore. The man wrote my name and his name together on roads and buildings. Whenever we opened our house door, the wall in front would have that name."

The Bhabiji Ghar Par Hain! actress added, "Peeche aana, bike pe chakkar lagana. Bus fir ek din meri sister ne unse baat kari ki yeh sab karke kuch nahi hone waala hai. You be something and achieve something, and then come and we'll talk. Bahut zayada dara deta hai yeh. Hum itna sunte hain, rapes and all, gharwaale waise hi dar jaate hain (He would follow me on his bike and keep circling around. Then, one day, my sister spoke to him and said that nothing would come out of doing all this. She told him to become something, achieve something, and then come back, and we'll talk. He scares us a lot. We hear so much about rapes and all, so our family naturally gets scared)."

The actress concluded by speaking about the need and importance of taking action and speaking up against stalking and harassment, adding that incidents like these affect young women so deeply that they often fear stepping out of the house.

Shubhangi was last seen as Angoori in Bhabiji Ghar Par Hain!, a role she played for nearly nine years before leaving the show in 2025. She also starred in the 2026 film Bhabiji Ghar Par Hain! Fun On The Run.

Shubhangi became a household name for her role in Kasturi. Kasturi premiered in 2007, starring Karan Patel and Shubhangi Atre in the lead roles. It followed the story of a young woman whose life changes after she meets Robbie, a wealthy businessman.

## Jatin Pandit Calls Out Raghav Juyal, Niharika NM's Aankhon Se Tune 2.0: 'I Didn't Like The Remix...'

Sharing his thoughts on his YouTube channel, the veteran composer said the remake stripped the essence of the original track. According to him, what was once an emotional romantic melody has been transformed into a high-energy dance number that lacks the soul and sentiment of the original composition.

The recreated version begins with a newly written verse, performed by Dev Negi and Palak Muchhal, before seamlessly transitioning into the original vocals of Kumar Sanu and Alka Yagnik. Veteran composer Jatin Pandit began the video by expressing his gratitude to fans for their unwavering love and support over the years before sharing his thoughts on the recreated version of the song.

He said, "I recently came across the remix of Aankhon Se Tune and realised it had over 23 million views. Then I realised this was our song from Ghulam. The original album had six songs, and every one of them was created with a lot of honesty and creativity. They kept Alka Yagnik and Kumar Sanu's voice, but the new version seems like it was AI-generated in its arrangement, which I don't know how they did... This is a very youthful and honest composition. There is no cheating in it. It came straight from the heart. As a composer, I didn't like the remix because this is not a dancing song. It's a moderate song with a moderate rhythm and movement. By increasing the tempo, density and adding a dance beat, its character has changed."

Jatin Pandit went on to recall the effort that had gone into



recording the original song, noting that it continues to be remembered even today, which, according to him, is one of the reasons the recreated version has garnered attention. He continued, "But the song is one direction and the arrangement in another direction. The soul of the song is here and the rhythm is in the opposite side. Mujhe samajh nahi aata ki shuru mein jo do original lagaye hai uski kya jarurat thi? Jo bhi hain doston main request karta hoon ki remix suna hai toh original bhi suniye. Original mein gaane mein thehrav aur ek purity hain... jab purity hamper hota hain toh dukh hota hai. Music ka kya future hone wala hai samajh mein nahi ata."

The original Aankhon Se Tune Kya Keh Diya featured in the 1998 film Ghulam, directed by Vikram Bhatt and starring Aamir Khan and Rani Mukerji. Composed by the iconic duo Jatin-Lalit and sung by Kumar Sanu and Alka Yagnik, the romantic track emerged as one of the film's most-loved songs. Nearly three decades later, it continues to enjoy enduring popularity among music lovers.

## Cocktail 2 OTT Release Date: When And Where To Watch Shahid Kapoor, Rashmika Mandanna, Kriti Sanon Film

Cocktail 2, starring Shahid Kapoor, Rashmika Mandanna and Kriti Sanon, will stream on Netflix from August 14, 2026. Check its OTT release details and plot.

After a successful run in theatres, Cocktail 2 is now set to make its digital debut. The romantic drama, headlined by Shahid Kapoor, Rashmika Mandanna and Kriti Sanon, will begin streaming this month, giving audiences another chance to catch one of the year's biggest Hindi releases from the comfort of their homes.

Directed by Homi Adajania, the film serves as a spiritual successor to the 2012 hit Cocktail. While it retains the emotional complexities and youthful energy associated with the original, it tells an entirely new story with a fresh set of characters.

The makers have confirmed that Cocktail 2 will premiere on Netflix on August 14, 2026.

The film first arrived in cinemas on June 19 and went on to emerge as one of the highest-grossing Hindi films of the year. Although critical opinion remained divided, audiences responded positively, helping the romantic drama become the sixth highest-grossing Bollywood release of 2026.

Its digital release is now expected to introduce the film to an even wider audience.

Unlike the 2012 film starring Saif Ali Khan, Deepika Padukone and Diana Penty, Cocktail 2 does not continue the earlier story. Instead, it explores a new relationship drama built around trust, friendship and unexpected emotions.

The story revolves around Kunal and Diya, a couple who travel to Sicily



hoping to escape constant pressure from their families to settle down.

Things take an unexpected turn when Diya asks her free-spirited friend Ally to flirt with Kunal as a way of testing his loyalty. What begins as an innocent experiment soon spirals into an emotional dilemma after Ally develops genuine feelings for him, leaving all three characters caught in a complicated situation.

The film examines modern relationships through a mix of romance, humour and emotional conflict, while staying rooted in Homi Adajania's signature storytelling style.
