

Yash's Toxic to see RECORD-BREAKING box office collection in Karnataka



Yash is gearing up for one of the biggest theatrical rollouts Karnataka has ever witnessed. Ahead of its worldwide release, Toxic: A Fairy Tale for Grown-Ups is being positioned to shatter existing box office records in the actor's home state, with the makers eyeing the widest-ever release for a Kannada film.

As anticipation builds towards the trailer launch, fans have already flooded social media with countdown posts and fan edits of Toxic. Let's take a look at how massive Toxic's Karnataka release is shaping up to be, and why the film could rewrite box office history.

Toxic is being mounted as the biggest theatrical release in Karnataka's history, with the makers

aiming to secure almost every single screen and multiplex across the state on day one. Yash's home banner Monster Mind Creations has partnered with KVN Productions to handle distribution themselves, marking Yash's entry into distribution alongside his roles as actor and producer.

This gives the team direct control over the film's rollout in Karnataka, and insiders describe the release pattern as one that could break every record previously set by the KGF franchise.

Bengaluru is expected to witness an all-time high number of Day One screenings, and the makers are reportedly planning early morning and special shows to accommodate the massive demand

across the state. With Toxic's release date just weeks away, the big question on everyone's mind is whether this Yash starrer can dethrone KGF Chapter 2's record for the biggest opening day at the Karnataka box office with a gross of Rs 26.5 crore. Rishab Shetty's Kantara Chapter 1 came close to breaking that record but ultimately fell short, opening at Rs 23.5 crore on day one.

Ever since the project was announced, Toxic has remained one of the most anticipated films of the year. From its striking first look and chart-topping songs Tabaahi and Madhosh, people are really excited to see how director Geetu Mohandas' ambitious movie is going to turn out.

Varun Dhawan To Star in YRF's First-Ever Horror Film, 2027 Release Planned



Varun Dhawan is all set to enter the horror genre with Yash Raj Films' first-ever horror feature. The much-awaited project is expected to hit theatres in 2027 and will be directed by Abhay Pannu, known for Rocket Boys. The makers have been tight-lipped about details of the story and Varun's character, but the collaboration is an interesting new step for both the actor and the production house.

According to sources close to YRF, Varun Dhawan has been roped in to headline the banner's first horror film. The project marks YRF's entry into the horror genre and is being planned as a theatrical release.

The film is expected to go on floors later this year, with the makers eyeing a 2027 release. While details about the story and Varun's character are currently being kept under wraps, the project is expected to explore a different side of the actor.

The horror film will be directed by Abhay Pannu, who is best known for creating and directing the acclaimed series Rocket Boys. Pannu has also written the screenplay for the upcoming project.

His move from the world of historical drama to horror adds another interesting element to the film, especially as this will be his theatrical film directorial debut.

The upcoming horror film will also mark Varun Dhawan's second collaboration with Yash Raj Films. The actor previously worked with the banner in Sui Dhaaga: Made In India, which also starred Anushka Sharma.

With this project, Varun is set to explore a genre that he has not headlined in his filmography so far, while YRF will venture into a completely new space with its first horror feature.

YRF is stepping into horror, which is a big move for the production house that has a huge legacy in mainstream Hindi cinema. The banner has successfully built franchises and films around romance, action and drama, but horror remains largely uncharted territory for the studio. Yash Raj Films has largely been associated with romance, action, drama and its expanding spy universe. Its decision to enter the horror space with Varun Dhawan at the centre has already made the project one to watch.

Box Office collection Day 9: Tom Holland and Zendaya's movie crosses Rs 400 crore gross in India

Spider-Man: Brand New Day Box Office collection Day 9: The one movie that no one can stop talking about right now is Spider-Man: Brand New Day. This movie is Marvel's fourth instalment of the Spider-Man franchise. You will get to see Tom Holland and Zendaya be back to reprise their roles for this movie.

Spider-Man: Brand New Day is currently in the second week of its theatrical run and has crossed Rs 400 crore gross in India box office collections. This movie is set four years after the events of Spider-Man: No Way Home. Let's dive in to see the Spider-Man Brand: New Day box office collection for day 9 here.

Marvel's Spider-Man: Brand New Day continues its powerful run at the Indian box office as it enters its ninth day in theatres. Kicking its second weekend on Friday, the film's Day 9 box office collection is estimated at Rs 14.50 crore across 13,544 screenings nationwide. Showing a 1.8% uptick from Thursday, this solid Friday performance pushes the movie's total domestic net earnings to Rs 349.25 crore, while its cumulative gross collection in India has reached Rs 417.63 crore.

The Tom Holland starrer has been breaking major financial records since day one. It opened with a massive Rs 60.60 crore net on Day 1, zipped past Rs 100 crore on Day 2 (Rs



109.95 crore), crossed Rs 150 crore on Day 3, breached Rs 200 crore on Day 4, topped Rs 300 crore in Week 1 (Rs 334.75 crore), and has now comfortably crossed the Rs 340 crore net milestone on Day 9.

Heading into its second weekend, audience turnout for the Marvel spectacle remained robust across the country. The film's momentum

was largely driven by key metro centres across formats, with English screenings bringing in Rs 8.75 crore net and Hindi dubbed versions contributing Rs 4.75 crore net. Standing at a domestic gross of Rs 417.63 crore in just nine days, Spider-Man: Brand New Day remains on course for a historic theatrical run in India.
